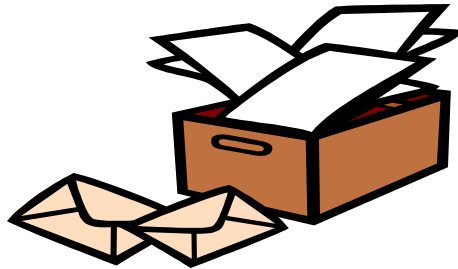


Corrugated Cardboard



*What is Corrugated Cardboard??

~Corrugated Cardboard is the thick, usually brown, cardboard with a wavy core.

***Corrugated Cardboard MUST be recycled according to State Law and Municipal Ordinance! Everyone, including businesses & residents, must recycle their corrugated cardboard!**

*Corrugated Cardboard must be flattened and cut to 2'x3'. If there are several boxes, they must be tied in a bundle with string.

*Corrugated Cardboard CANNOT go in the regular garbage.

*Mixing corrugated cardboard with garbage can result in fines up to \$99 per violation.

*Corrugated Cardboard can also be brought to the Middletown Recycling Center on the corner of Johnson Street and North Main Street.

*A resident's pass to use the Recycling Center can be obtained from the Department of Public Works in the Municipal Building. The vehicle registration of the vehicle that will be used must be presented to obtain the pass.

* There is no charge to recycle corrugated cardboard at the Recycling Center. Recycle all you want!
