### REMARKS

On 11/8/2016, at approximately 2235 hours, Detective Lathrop and I were traveling southbound on High Street south of Liberty Street. I observed a white Subaru Outback, bearing CT registration AF05209, traveling in front of my unmarked police cruiser. The vehicle had a tinted plastic cover over the rear license plate in violation of 14-18(a). I then observed the vehicle fail to stop at the marked state stop sign at the intersection of High Street and Liberty Street, and then at High Street and Grand Street. I activated our emergency lights and initiated a traffic stop.

The vehicle was occupied by the operator and two passenger. The rear passenger was later identified as Rudolph Durazzo through prior arrest photos and law enforcement interactions.

I know through prior investigations and interactions that all three individuals have been arrested for selling narcotics. I requested Officer Del Mauro and his narcotics detecting canine, Killian, come to the scene and conduct a free air sniff around the vehicle, while I ran the parties through dispatch and completed a written warning. Killian alerted to the vehicle indicating the presence of narcotics within.

I had the occupants exit the vehicle and in Durazzo's right front small pant pocket I found a receipt that was wrapped around a small rocklike object, which I was immediately able to identify through my training and experience as suspected


crack cocaine. There was no other contraband on the occupants or in the vehicle.

The suspected crack cocaine tested positive with NARK 13 and later weighed .1 grams on a department scale.


Durazzo was release on a PTA under MSC MC378201 for violation of CGS 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Narcotics.

A witness to the crash, , was sitting in her vehicle, near where the crash occurred. She said that Carles hit the other vehicle went attempting to pull into a parking spot. She said that Carles stopped, got out of her vehicle and looked at the one she had hit, got back in her vehicle and parked several spots away. The vehicle that she struck was in pristine condition and did not have any other damage to it. The damage that Carles caused was very obvious.


I asked Carles why she then pulled several spaces away to park her vehicle. She said that she knew she got close to hitting the car and "didn't want to risk it," trying to park again. requested that an arrest be made.

Carles was arrested. She was charged with Evading, CGS 14-244(a). She was assigned a court date of 11-22-16, issued a misdemeanor summons and released.

## REMARKS

On November 13, 2016 at 2202 hours, I, a Middletown Police Officer was on routine patrol in a marked police cruiser traveling southbound on Saybrook Road.

I observed a green, 1995 Honda Prelude bearing CT. Reg. 865HPA also traveling southbound on Saybrook Road in front of me. I made a DMV Inquiry regarding the registration plate through Central Dispatch. I was advised that there was no record found for the above mentioned registration.

The vehicle then turned westbound on Hillside Avenue. I initiated a motor vehicle stop by enacting my emergency lights and siren. The operator of the vehicle responded by pulling over onto the shoulder of the roadway.

I made contact with the operator; Jesse Kline (22 YO) who was identified by his CT Identification Card #139186162. I advised Kline of the reason for the motor vehicle stopped and asked him to provide me with his license, registration and insurance. Kline advised me that he did not have a license and he recently purchased the vehicle and it was not registered or insured. He provided me with the title to the vehicle which showed that he purchased the vehicle two week prior.

## REMARKS

On 11/16/16 at 19:35 hours, I, Officer Ortiz responded in front of 133 Eastern Drive, Middletown on a reported motor vehicle accident. It was reported that a vehicle struck a parked, but unoccupied motor vehicle at said location. On arrival, I spoke with Joseph R. Canatta Joseph said that he was traveling north bound on Eastern Drive and took his eyes of the road to change the radio station and drifted across the south bound lane and struck a Ford Focus station wagon, which was unoccupied in front of 133 Eastern Drive.

and said that they heard the impact of the crash and looked out the front door. They said they saw the driver (Joseph) getting out of his vehicle and walking toward a storm drain. and said that Joseph reached into his pocket and threw something into the storm drain.

The storm drain was located across 139 Eastern Drive. I looked into the storm drain and I noticed four pieces of what appeared to be clear plastic baggies which contained white powdery substance, consistent with illegal narcotics, submerged in water.

I was unable to retrieve said items. Joseph denied the allegation. Joseph admitted that he's a recovering heroin addict, however, he did admit that he last used heroin about five hours ago.

I asked Joseph if he had any illegal dugs on his person, he said, no. I then patted Joseph front pocket for weapon and or drugs. I located an uncap, used hypodermic needle in his front right pocket. Joseph said that's the needle he used to inject himself with heroin earlier today.

The hypodermic needle was photographed prior to being discarded in a red bio-hazard container. Joseph was issued an MSC for possession of drug paraphernalia, 21a-267. Joseph was assigned a court date of 11/28/16 to appear at GA9 at 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On 11/17/2016, at approximately 1921hours, I was traveling westbound on Liberty Street approaching Pearl Street. I observed a tan Toyota Camry, bearing CT registration 8AJRN4, traveling southbound on Pearl Street, approaching Liberty Street. The windshield of the vehicle had a crack across the center, creating a view obstruction. I began to follow the vehicle. When it approached the intersection of Pearl Street and Washington Street, the vehicle stopped over the stop line, in the middle of the crosswalk. The vehicle then made a right turn onto Washington Street without signaling. I activated my overhead lights and initiated a traffic stop.

The operator, later identified as Dashawn Footman, provided me with his license, registration, and insurance. As we spoke I could detect the distinct odor of marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle. I was able to identify the odor through my training and experience. I saw in plain view, on the front passenger, a suspected marijuana cigarette. Footman admitted the cigarette did in fact have marijuana in it.

I had Footman exit the vehicle. I searched his person and in his right front pant pocket I found a baggie of suspected

marijuana that I was able to identify through my training and experience (later weighed 5.4 grams on a department scale). I recovered the marijuana cigarette from the front passenger seat (later weighed 1.3 grams on a department scale). I found numerous plastic baggies with marijuana residue inside the center console. Also in the center console I found a round pink pill with the imprint "K56". I identified the pill as Oxycodone Hydrochloride 10 mg through drugs.com. Oxycodone is a DEA/FDA schedule II narcotic substance available through prescription only.

The suspected marijuana tested positive with NARK 9.

Footman was taken into custody and transported to the Middletown Police Department, where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed.

Footman was released on a \$2500 non surety bond for violation of CGS 21a-279(a)(a)1 possession of less than 1/2 ounce of marijuana, and 21a-279(a) possession of narcotics. He is scheduled to appear at GA-9 in Middletown on 12/1/2016 at 0900 hours. Footman was given a written warning for 14-99f(a) defective windshield and 14-299 failure to obey traffic control.

The above stated items were tagged as evidence and placed in an evidence locker





REMARKS

On 11-19-16 at approximately 0114 hrs. Middletown Police Officers stopped a vehicle driven by Nathan Perdue for speeding on Rt. 9 north. The Officer initiating the motor vehicle stop watched as the passenger in the back seat appeared to put something or retrieve something from under the passenger side front seat.

Concerned the passenger may be concealing or retrieving a weapon the occupants were removed from the vehicle. During a pat down of the area where the Officer saw the occupant reaching, a capped syringe and glass pipe with burn marks on both ends was found. Upon finding the items, Officers, through training and experience recognized the glass pipe, commonly referred to as a "stem" as a pipe used exclusively to smoke crack cocaine.

While searching the interior of the vehicle Officers located a pack of cigarettes on the front driver seat. Officers, also through training and experience, know drug users will often hide drugs and paraphernalia in packs of cigarettes to conceal the items from Police. Upon opening the pack of cigarettes another glass pipe with burn marks on both ends (stem) was found inside.

Purdue admitted the pack of cigarettes and the pipe were his. The other two occupants were searched with no contraband found. While searching Purdue, Officers located a small wax paper baggie stamped

with the phrase "Call of Duty". These baggies are often used by street level drug dealers to package heroin for resale. Drug dealers will use unique stamps to label the baggies as their specific product.

Purdue admitted that all contraband found belonged to him. Purdue was processed for violation of CGS 21a-267(A), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, given a court date of 12-1-16 at GA09 in Middletown and released on a \$2,500.00 non-surety bond.
