

Upon our arrival we met with Stop & Shop worker who explained that she had observed a female taking food from the shelves and attempted to leave the store without paying.

provided a voluntary sworn written statement stating she was watching the store CCTV video surveillance system around approximately 4:55pm. She witnessed a female, later identified as Jacalyn Whittemore, driving the store power assisted scooter around the store. Whittemore placed several items into the scooter basket (frozen breakfast sandwiches, bags of potato chips, and candies). Whittemore then covered the items with her own personal bag and went outside without attempting to pay. walked outside and confronted Whittemore. She then escorted Whittemore back inside where they waited for Police to arrive. stated, on behalf of the store, she would be pressing charges.

provided a receipt for the recovered items which totaled \$108.79. Whittemore was advised that she would not be allowed on the property and would be arrested for trespassing if she returned. She stated she understood. The statement was submitted with the case documents.

Whittemore was issued a misdemeanor summons (MC 379902) for violation of CGS 53a-125b Larceny 6th degree. She was given a court date of 10/24/16 at 0900hrs and told she would have to appear at the GA9 Court House on that date and time. She stated she understood. Nothing further.





REMARKS

On 10-12-2016 at approximately 0929 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to headquarters for an assault.

Upon arrival I spoke with the victim who stated he was robbed and assaulted by Steven Rios and two other males. The victim displayed visible bruising to the face and was later transported to Middlesex hospital for further medical treatment.

At the hospital, the victim further explained he met Rios who introduced him to two other males. They were going to buy cigarettes when the victim decided to stop by his apartment to drop off his back pack. While in a back alley off of Main St. the victim was punched in the face by Rios and the two other males. The victims stated issued cell phone (\$20 value) and his wallet containing miscellaneous items and \$87.00 were taken.

The victim went to his apartment to clean up and then located Rios and the other two suspects outside of Arescos market. He asked for his items back and Rios and the two males threatened to beat him up again and chased him away. The victim then went to the police department and reported the robbery.

The victim gave a sworn written statement of the incident and gave consent for me to photograph his injuries. He positively identified Rios as one of the three suspects who assaulted him and he wished to press charges.

During my investigation, Rios was located on Liberty St. and later arrested and transported to headquarters. He admitted to being outside in the area but denied involvement in the altercation. He gave limited details about who he was with when the incident occurred. It should be noted Rios did not have any visible injuries on his hands which would have verified he assaulted the victim.

Based on the victim's statement and injuries there was still sufficient evidence to pursue charges against Rios. He was later charged on the above violations and held on a \$25,000 surety bond. He will be arraigned on 10-13-2016 at GA 9 and was identified by prior in house photographs.


After approximately another five minutes, the second suspect, , exited the store and proceeded



Bianca stated that he and [redacted] primarily [redacted] had been joking around and had made comments to [redacted] about getting some of the cupcakes that she had just purchased and was carrying. They both denied making statements to the 15 year old but stated they had been joking. Bianca stated that [redacted] had made most of the statements and chastised him for the comments he had made.

I spoke with the 15 year old again. She was positive about the comments the two had made to her. The complainant requested arrests for this incident. I obtained a written and sworn statement from the 15 year old of the incident, and requesting an arrest.

Both were released on the scene on MSC's for Breach of Peace 2nd with a court date of 10-19-16 in GA 9.






