



REMARKS

On 10/07/2016 at approximately 19:01 hours I, Officer Austin Smith was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Washington Street and Melilli Plaza. One of the involved parties had called 911 to report the crash, but also stated that one of the drivers may be intoxicated.

After securing the scene and verifying that there were no injuries as a result of the crash, I identified the operator of the Chevrolet Silverado as Thomas Bierhacki

While speaking to Biernacki about the cause of the crash, I was able to detect the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. He stated that he was coming from Rhode Island where he was towing his boat back from. I asked Biernacki how many alcoholic beverages he had consumed tonight, he answered, "none." Biernacki was wearing dark sunglasses while speaking to me, it was now dark outside and I found this to be unusual. I asked if his sunglasses had corrective lenses, or if he needed them

to see. He answered no. I then asked him to remove them. Biernacki's eyes were glossy and bloodshot.

I asked Biernacki to hand me his license, vehicle registration and proof of insurance. I then observed him thumb through all the cards in his wallet several times. It appeared that he was having difficulty finding his license, but eventually located it. I then reminded him that I also needed his registration and proof of insurance. I then observed Biernacki lean across his vehicle to the passenger side and attempt to open his glove compartment. I watched him slide his hand across the dashboard multiple times as he struggle to locate the latch and open it. Once open I could see his vehicle documents and other belonging inside, indicating that he uses the compartment regularly.

I asked Biernacki to exit the vehicle. I explained that I suspected that he may be under the influence of alcohol and asked him to take the standardized field sobriety tests. Biernacki stated that he was not willing to perform the tests. I then asked him again in the presence of Officer Haddad and Sergeant Mazzota. He again stated that he was unwilling to perform any field sobriety tests.

Biernacki was charged with violating CGS 14-227a Operating a motor vehicle under the influence and 14-218a* Traveling too fast for conditions.

Biernacki was released on a \$500.00 non-surety bond and has a scheduled court appearance at GA09 Middletown on 10/21/2016 at 09:00 hours.

REMARKS

On 10/11/16, at 0150 hours I was on patrol and was driving south on Camp Street. I came to a red traffic light at the intersection with Washington St so I stopped my marked patrol suv. I observed a Black GMC Sierra pulled up past the stop bar on Washington St. It was in the left turn only lane facing westbound as if it were going to turn into the CT Beverage Mart/Goodwill parking lot. All of these businesses were closed at the time. The truck was a whole vehicle length past the stop bar when it was waiting.

My traffic light turned green and I took a left heading east on Washington St. As I drove past the truck it appeared that the operator was slumped over. I pulled into the Auto Zone parking lot (926 Washington St.) and turned my marked patrol suv so I was facing the Black GMC Sierra. I observed the green left turn arrow turn on for a cycle then go red then go back to green then back to red. The truck still remained parked in the intersection impeding the flow of the cars that were out there and the truck didn't turn left when instructed to by the green arrow.

I drove up behind the vehicle and had dispatch check the MA license plate 13AX31, which came back to a black GMC Sierra owned by Jamie Pike. The light cycled through a green turn arrow again and the truck didn't turn. I activated my overhead lights and stepped out of the vehicle. I approached the driver's side and could see the vehicle still running and in drive. The operator, later identified as Jamie Pike, had his feet off the gas and brake and was sleeping. His chin was touching his chest and he was leaning against the window. I knocked on his window for about two minutes before he woke up. Jamie Pike looked startled and was moving his head back and forth trying to look around and figure out what was going on. I immediately noticed that his eyes were extremely blood shot and glassy. I told him to roll his window down and he only rolled it down to about his chin level. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath.

I asked him what he was doing and he looked confused and stuttered and mumbled something. I again asked him what he was doing and he said nothing. I told him that he was asleep behind the wheel and he didn't say anything. I asked him where he was coming from and he said New York. I told him to roll his window down all the way and he scoffed at me and refused to do it. Jamie Pike failed a pre exit sobriety test.

I told him to exit the vehicle and that we were going to be conducting Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST's) on him. Ofc. Ward conducted the SFST's as I witnessed Jamie Pike fail them all.

Jamie Pike was handcuffed and placed under arrest and transported to HQ for processing. Ofc. Ward read Jamie Pike his notice of rights at 0225 hours and he signed them stating he understands them. Ofc. Ward then read the Implied consent advisory at 0228 hours and told Jamie Pike that he would be choosing to do the breath test. Jamie Pike stated that he wanted counsel. We told him that there was a phone in front of him and he said "No there isn't that's a wall in front of me." I told him to look down in front of him and there was a black landline telephone for him to use. He ignored us and gave us a hard time while looking away from us.

We told him that he can call an attorney if he chooses to and he said he will when his attorney wakes up. We told him that we can't wait that long because we have a certain time to perform these tests. He stated that he doesn't like these games. We told him that it wasn't a game and that he has the option to call an attorney if he chooses, but if he doesn't than we will have to take this as a refusal. Jamie Pike stated that he wasn't going to call an attorney at this time. Ofc. Ward entered the refusal into the Drager.

I issued him a MSC #MC330314 and charged him with DUI 14-227a, and Failure to follow a control signal 14-299. He was given a court date of 10/25/16 and a \$500 non-surety bond.

REMARKS

On Tuesday 10-12-2016 at approximately 2000 hours Detective Peck and I (Detective Lathrop) were conducting surveillance in the area of Liberty Street and High Street in an unmarked police vehicle. This is a high crime area with numerous documented incidents of narcotics related arrests. The narcotics unit has recently received information that drug sales have been occurring in this area from arrested persons, concerned citizens and confidential informants.

We observed a gray Volkswagen Jetta, bearing Connecticut registration marker 9AGXV6 pull out from a side of the street parking space and continue S/B on High Street at a high rate of speed. The Jetta then went through a yellow light at the intersection of High Street and Washington Street and proceeded S/B on High Street. We followed the Jetta as it continued

S/B on High Street and continued to observe the vehicle. The Jetta traveled over the double yellow lines several times as it continued S/B on High Street towards Highland Avenue. I enacted our emergency lights and siren and initiated a motor vehicle stop on the Jetta for the failure to maintain proper lane violation and the traffic control signal violation.

The vehicle came to a stop at the intersection of Highland Avenue and Beacon Street. I approached the vehicle on the driver side and Detective Peck approached on the passenger side. As I approached I observed the operator as he rolled down the front driver side window. The operator, later identified as Steven J. Ziemba from his CT operator's license seemed to be very nervous as I got to the window. I asked Ziemba for his operator's license, registration, and proof of insurance. While doing so I observed Ziemba's hands which were noticeably shaking. I asked Ziemba why his hands were shaking and where he was coming from. He paused for several seconds and looked directly at me and appeared to be confused. Ziemba then stated "From Middletown". I asked him where in Middletown he was coming from and he again paused and stated "Main Street". At this time I knew Ziemba was being untruthful with his answers. As I was looking into the passenger compartment of the vehicle I could see several small plastic baggies on the passenger side floor that I was able to identify as tear baggies from my training and experience as a narcotics detective.

I asked Ziemba if there was anything illegal in the vehicle or on his person and Ziemba stated there was not. I asked Ziemba to step out of the vehicle which he did without incident. A pat down of Ziemba revealed 4 yellow pills which Ziemba said were Gabapentin. I asked Ziemba if he had a prescription for Gabapentin and he stated he did not. Ziemba then admitted to getting the Gabapentin from a friend. I placed Ziemba in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness. I advised Ziemba he was being detained until a further search of his person and vehicle was completed.

A search of the vehicle revealed 4 total tear bags. Tear bags are clear plastic baggies with the ends tied in knots and plastic baggies with the ends cut off normally used to transport and deliver cocaine and crack cocaine. When asked about the tear bags Ziemba stated he has a drug problem and uses crack cocaine. No other contraband was found in the vehicle or on the person of Ziemba. I then told Ziemba he was under arrest for illegally obtaining prescription meds and for possession drug of paraphernalia.


The 4 Gabapentin pills were identified by Detective Peck on scene using the Drugs.com Pill Identifier as Gabapentin 300mg. Gabapentin is not a controlled substance but is available by prescription only.

The 4 Gabapentin pills and the tear bags were secured as evidence and transported to MPD headquarters and logged into the MPD evidence department.

I issued Ziemba Misdemeanor Summons # MC378293 in violation of CGS 21a-108 Illegally Obtaining Prescription Drugs, 21a-267a Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and 14-226 Failure to Maintain Lane. Ziemba was issued a copy of his summons and issued a court date of 10-26-2016 at GA-09 located at 1 Court Street Middletown CT 06457.

Ziemba has no prior criminal history.

REMARKS

On 10/18/16, at approximately 13:01 hours, the accused was observed operating a light green colored Subaru Legacy bearing CT. reg. 2AUUX4 south on Main Street. The accused vehicle did not have properly functioning brake lamps and there was no front plate on the vehicle. A traffic stop of the vehicle was initiated on Main Street.

The accused produced an insurance card which was expired as of 10/14/16. At that time, I spoke with the accused outside of the vehicle. During the course of the investigation, the accused appeared nervous and kept looking back at the car. When asked if there was anything in the vehicle that I should be concerned about she told me there was not.

During the course of the search of the vehicle, I located the following: two white and orange colored capped needles, a rubber banded package containing 11 small waxy bags with a light brownish colored powder like substance which appeared to be Heroin, a container containing Narcan nasal spray 4mg, a "One hitter" small smoking pipe and in a key chain containing a white pill and yellow pill that was later determined to be Gabapentin. The brownish substance was later tested with a Nark Kit and weighed a total of 2.53 grams.

At that time, the accused was placed under arrest and later transported to Middletown Police Department for processing. The accused was held on a \$15,000.00 bond and was charged with Nicolletta was charged with the following: 21a-279(a) - Possession of Narcotics, 21a-278(A)- Possession with intent to sell narcotics, 21a-267(a)- Possession of drug paraphernalia, 21a-257- Possession of prescription medication not in original container, 14-96c- Improper tail light and 14-18(a)- No front plate. A court date of 10/19/16 at 09:00 hours at Middlesex Superior Court was issued.

REMARKS

On 10/18/2016 at approximately 2151 hours, Officer Remotti and I, Officer DiMassa were dispatched to the area of Main Street and Ferry Street to investigate a robbery complaint. It was reported by the victim, who was later identified as [redacted] that a tall black male who was wearing a red shirt and khaki pants grabbed him from behind and took \$10.00 from him. Several other officer responded to the scene to assist with my investigation, including Lieutenant Maturo and Sergeant Mazzotta.

When we arrived, Officer Remotti and I located the victim [redacted] : and his wife

Officer Remotti then interviewed _____ later provided Officer Remotti with a sworn written statement reiterating what he initially stated at the scene. _____ stated that on 10/18/16 at approximately 9:50PM, he was walking north on Main St., on the east side of the road crossing Ferry St. _____ stated that as he was walking in front of Fengs Place on Main St., a black male who was approximately 6 feet tall, who was wearing khaki pants, and a red sweatshirt, grabbed him from behind holding his left arm with his left hand, and reached into his right pant pocket, removing a \$10.00 bill. _____ stated that this black male then ran into 568 Main St. _____ stated that he then attempted to run after the black male but he slammed the entrance door of 568 Main St. shut. _____ stated that he then kicked the entrance door to 568 Main St. open which led to a stairwell to the second floor of the building. _____ stated that he was unable to locate the black male who ran inside of the building. _____ stated that when the police arrived they located the black male that robbed him inside of the building and the police walked him out of the building. _____ stated that when the police later escorted the black male out of the building, he stated that he was 100% certain that the black male committed the robbery against him.


I then interviewed _____ who was initially yelling stating that _____ kicked in the entrance door to the apartment building that she lived in, which was 568 Main St. She was yelling that when _____ kicked in the door, the noise startled her, so she exited her apartment to see why the door was kicked in. She stated that _____ was yelling stating that the tall black male that just robbed him went into the apartment building. _____ then told me that she saw the tall black male, who was wearing a red shirt, enter 568 Main St., and then go into the rear apartment on the second floor.


After getting this information from _____ she then led us to the apartment that she saw the tall black male enter. Sergeant Mazzotta, Officers Remotti, Wasilewski, St. Peter, and myself went into the apartment building to the rear apartment, where we encountered a tall black male, who was wearing a blue shirt, who was later identified as _____. I then detained _____ in handcuffs, for investigative purposes. As I did this, the resident of the rear apartment came out of his apartment to calm _____ down who was screaming as loud as he could that he had hip surgery and that when we sat him down, we aggravated his hip. As the door was opened Officer Wasilewski and Officer St. Peter were able to see inside of the rear apartment, and they immediately saw a tall black male wearing a red shirt, who they knew from past police encounters as Christopher White (_____ Refer to Officer Wasilewski and Officer St. Peter's supplemental reports for the details to this part of the investigation.

As Officer St. Peter was escorting White to a cruiser for transport, _____ who was outside of the apartment building on Main St., immediately identified White as the black male that robbed him as he walked by him.

White was later transported to police headquarters by Officer Jefferies, who later booked and processed him for violation of C.G.S 53a-136-Robbery in the Third Degree, 53a-123-Larceny in the Second Degree, and 53a-181-Breach of Peace in the Second Degree. He was processed under UAR 8873625 and he was issued a court date of 10/19/16 at 0900 hours at GA 9, Middletown. White was held on a \$50,000 Surtey bond. There is no further information. This case is closed by the arrest of Christopher White.




