DOMESTIC

This incident is a physical domestic dispute between a MALE and a FEMALE who have been involved in a dating relationship and share custody of their nine year old child. Both the MALE and the FEMALE are VICTIMS and SUSPECTS in this incident. Hereinafter, the MALE will be referred to as VICTIM #1 and the FEMALE will be referred to as VICTIM #2.

On 10/19/2016, at approximately 1900 hours I, Officer Foster, was dispatched to an undisclosed address in Middletown on the report of a physical domestic with injuries. Initial reports from dispatch were that Victim #2 was reporting she was choked by her ex-boyfriend Victim #1. Victim #2 was declining any medical attention and stated Victim #1 was still present in the apartment.


As I entered the stairway to the second floor, I could hear a male's voice yelling and swearing. The door was unlocked and entry into the apartment was made. Victim #1 was quickly detained without incident and was brought into the hallway area to defuse the situation. Victim #1 stated he briefly put his hands on Victim #2 to defend himself. Victim #1 had very minor scratches on his neck and facial area. Victim #2 had noticeable bruising on her neck area and superficial lacerations


as well. Victim #2 provided me with a sworn written statement. The statement explained that Victim #1 choked Victim #2 after she asked him to leave in front of their juvenile son. Victim #2 stated she was gasping for air and at one point he put his knee in her throat. Victim #2 stated she tried to dial 911 after being released and Victim #1 re-engaged by choking her again. Victim #2 confirmed that she did push Victim #1 prior to the assault and engaged in the altercation.

Based on the statements by both parties and the physical evidence provided, the probable cause was found to make an arrest of both Victim #1 and Victim #2. Victim #1 was transported to Middletown Police HQ to be processed and book. Victim #2 was issued a Misdemeanor Summons, MC330378, for violation of C.G.S. 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct with a court date of October 20, 2016 at GA9.

Victim #1 was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-21 Risk of Injury to a minor, violation of C.G.S. 53a-61 Assault 3rd, violation of C.G.S. 53a-64bb Strangulation 2nd, violation of C.G.S. 53a-96 Unlawful Restraint 2nd, and violation of C.G.S. 53a-183b interfering with an Emergency Call. Victim #1 was held on a \$50,000 surety bond and will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on October 20, 2016 at 0900 hours.

A DCF referral was made and submitted.



He further stated that his vehicle was both uninsured and unregistered. Medina added that he took the plate off of his Mercury Mountaineer. 


