

told me at approx. 1130 hours he was taking out the garbage when Domnique Pringle approached him and wanted to fight, Domnique then pulled out a large folding knife and started swinging it at him. states he was able to avoid the knife by running around the parked cars in the driveway.

Domnique did cut the front of [redacted] shirt with the knife but did not make contact with him. [redacted] stated his girlfriend, [redacted], her mom, [redacted] and her sister [redacted] came outside and broke it up.

[redacted] states he then grabbed a baseball bat and drove away with his girlfriend, Domnique jumped in his car and followed them. [redacted] states they stopped for the traffic light at the intersection of Randolph & South Main St. Domnique struck the rear of the vehicle with the front bumper of his vehicle. [redacted] got out to look at the damage and Domnique tried to run him over and as he came around a second time at him, that's when [redacted] states he took the baseball bat and smashed the drivers side window. [redacted] then jumped back into the vehicle and drove a few blocks away once they felt safe and Domnique was not following them, they decided to drive to the police department to report it, and that's when [redacted] mother, [redacted] called [redacted] and told her Domnique returned to the residence and smashed all the windows out to her vehicle.

[redacted] and [redacted] gave written statements requesting Domnique Pringle be placed under arrest. [redacted] vehicle a 2011 Chevy, Impala, 4 door, red, CT. Reg. #603 WSW, had all the windows smashed, which looked like an axe was used as there was an axe by the garage, and officer Foss-Rugan found a small zip lock baggie of suspected PCP weighing .56 grams on the ground by the vehicle. Officer Foss-Rugan tagged the axe and the suspected PCP and placed them in locker #4 as evidence. Attached are several photos of the damage to [redacted] car.

Harford Police Department assisted and was able to locate Domnique Pringle at his residence, 56 Coolidge St., Hartford, CT., and they detained him, and released him to Officer Walsilewski and Foster, who placed Domnique under arrest, transported him back to headquarters, where he was processed on the above charges, Criminal attempt to commit Assault 1st 53a-49/53a-59, Criminal Mischief 1st 53a-115, Larceny 3rd 53a-124, and placed in cell #9, on a \$80,000.00 surety bond, with a court date of 10/26/16.

REMARKS

On 10/22/16 at approximately 2029hrs Officer Tiano and I (Officer Wasilewski) were dispatched to a report of an alarm coming from 120 Washington Street, the Exclusive Furs business. Officer Tiano and I parked 3-4 buildings east of 120 Washington Street and walked eastbound toward the business which is located directly on the corner of Washington Street and Wetmore.


As Officer Tiano and I started walking toward Wetmore we observed a black male wearing a brown baseball hat, brown coat, jeans, and black shoes walking westbound on the sidewalk approximately 30 yards away. We then rounded the corner of Washington and Wetmore when he observed a rock on the ground outside on the sidewalk. We then saw a large floor to ceiling picture window smashed. As we noticed the window smashed we immediately ran over to where we last saw the black male on the sidewalk. Officer Tiano and I then yelled "Stop!" to get the unidentified male's attention. The suspect immediately began running and ran behind one of the buildings by 150 or 160 Washington Street and proceeded north or northeast. Officer Tiano and I lost sight of him.

The suspect lost his hat while he was running from Officer Tiano and I. Officer Tiano and I lost sight of the suspect by Glover Place. The hat was secured and used as a scent article for a K9 track. The track turned up negative. The owner of the store (later identified as _____) arrived and allowed us to view the video surveillance footage from the two exterior cameras and one interior. The video showed the suspect leaning on the window with his shoulder in an attempt to push it in. He looks inside then walks to the rear of the store. At 2025hrs the suspect walks west and returns with a rock in his hand approximately 1.5-2 times the size of a softball. The suspect then throws the large rock at the window 4 times. At 2026 the suspect stops throwing the rock and walks out toward Wetmore to look around and see if anyone is nearby. He returns and leans on the window again with his body weight. He also kicks the glass several times. The suspect then walks away for approximately 8-9 minutes and returns around 2035hrs. The suspect gains entry into the building by pushing on the large glass window that was now hinged like a door and partially swinging inward. The store footage shows the suspect running through the store as Officer Tiano and I (Officer Wasilewski) pull up. As Officer Tiano and I start walking eastbound from approximately 50-75 yards away, the suspect is inside the store and grabs one of the black fur coats hanging on the "\$50" dollar rack. He exits the store and begins running after told to STOP! by Officer Tiano and I (Officer Wasilewski).

A photo taken by this Officer of the video surveillance screen was submitted with the case documents. Sergeant Lukanik immediately identified the suspect as Terrance Harding. Sergeant Petrusis, Officer Tiano, and I (Officer Wasilewski) went to the last know address of Harding and made contact with him. Harding was taken into custody and brought to the Middletown Police Department where he was read his rights and processed. Harding provided Officers with a voluntary sworn written statement admitting to breaking into the store and stealing the fur coat. Harding was charged with violation of CGS 53a-103 Burglary 3rd Degree, 53a-115 Criminal Mischief 1st Deg, 53a-125b Larceny 6th, and 53a-167a Interfering with an Officer. He was released on a \$50,000 non-surety bond and issued a court date of 11/7/16 at 0900hrs. He was told he would have to appear at the GA 9 court house on that date and time. Nothing further.

The store owner stated they would provide the video footage to this Officer on 10/26/16 as evidence. Once it is provided it will be submitted as evidence. Nothing further.

REMARKS

On 10/14/2016 at 1757hrs, I Ofc. Sanford, responded to an evading motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Ballfall Road and Westfield Street. While clearing that initial call, a second motor vehicle accident involving the evading motor vehicle occurred at the intersection of Newfield Street and Liberty Street.

The evading vehicle, a 2005 Toyota Avalon bearing CT reg "AD62150" was operated by Deandre Lawrence (CT DL#118527822). When I asked Lawrence about the first accident, Lawrence stated the motorcycle had backed into him, stating he had provided adequate space between the vehicles. While I spoke with Lawrence, I detected the odor of alcohol emanating from Lawrence's breath.

I asked Lawrence if he had been drinking, and he stated he had one beer. I also observed a Budweiser beer bottle in Lawrence's center console.

I asked Lawrence to perform the standardized field sobriety tests. Lawrence stated he had no medical issues that would inhibit his ability to perform the tests.

Lawrence failed the horizontal gaze nystagmus, walk-turn and one leg stand.

Lawrence was transported to the Middletown Police Department and read his rights at 1856hrs. An A-44 form was completed with Lawrence performing two breath tests. The initial test at 1921hrs results in a .2097 result, and the second test at 1941hrs resulted in a .2066 result.

Lawrence was issued MSC#MC330315 for violating statues 14-227a- Operating a MV under the influence and 14-224 - Evading responsibility. Lawrence was released on a \$2,500 non-surety bond with a court date of 10/26/2016 0900hrs at Middletown Superior Court.

REMARKS

On 10/25/2016, at approximately 1815 hours I, Officer Foster, was patrolling the area of Inverness Lane after receiving information regarding illegal drug activity in the complex. As I approached the residence of 61 Inverness Lane, I observed a 2004 Acura RL 3.5 parked in a visitor spot with two male occupants. The operator, later identified as Jhakur West, quickly slumped over in his seat upon noticing my cruiser. West resides on the opposite side of town and is known to this department as a drug user and seller.

Upon exiting my cruiser, I observed West throw an object underneath his vehicle with his left hand. I approached West on

the driver's side and spoke to him through his already open door. I could smell the overwhelming odor of freshly burnt marijuana coming from West's vehicle and person. I advised West that I could smell marijuana and asked him to step out of the vehicle. West stated there was a small amount of marijuana located in the driver's door. Prior to searching the vehicle, I looked under the car to see what West had possibly thrown. I observed a sandwich baggie containing a fair amount of suspected marijuana. The marijuana was later weighed to 14.40 grams utilizing a department scale. Based on the contraband found, I advised West that he was under arrest at which time he was placed in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness.

Continuing the search of the vehicle I located the following:


- Numerous used and unused sandwich baggies
- Silver Apple iPhone 6
- Five burnt marijuana cigarettes (.89 grams)
- One hundred and six dollars

The amount of marijuana found in West's possession (much more than personal use) in conjunction with the manner of packaging led to the determination that West is actively conducting drug sales utilizing his vehicle. Based on the evidence, Jhakur West was transported to Middletown Police HQ. It is important to note to date, West has been charged on six different occasions for possession of marijuana dating back to March, 2015 including three by this Officer.

West was held on a 50,000 dollar surety bond and will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on October 26, 2016 at 0900 hours.


