
second Degree.

REMARKS

On 10/13/2016, at approximately 1738 hours I, Officer Foster, was parked on Silver Street observing motor vehicle traffic for violations. A dark colored green Honda Accord passed my location with a white male operator not wearing his seatbelt. I activated my emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop for the violation. The vehicle pulled to the right and came to a complete stop. I approached the operator on the driver's side and identified him as Michael Mclean by his Connecticut Driver's License. Mclean apologized for not wearing his seat belt and explained he was returning the vehicle to a customer who needed mechanical work done. Mclean smelt strongly of an alcoholic beverage and so did the vehicle.

Mclean admitted to taking a shot at work before he left but was adamant that was the only beverage he consumed. Mclean appeared nervous and was very fidgety in his seat. I asked Mclean to step out of the vehicle and speak with me on the adjacent sidewalk. I asked Mclean if he would consent to a field sobriety test. Mclean consented verbally. Prior to performing the tests, I asked Mclean if he had any weapons or contraband on his person. Mclean stated, "no" and invited me to check. As I reached into Mclean's front right pocket I pulled out a Newport cigarette box which had two white pills tucked into the cellophane.


I inquired about the prescription pills at which time Mclean identified them as Percocet's (Schedule II Narcotic). Mclean explained that he has back pain and is prescribed them through his doctor. Mclean

stated he stores the pills in that fashion before he leaves for work so they are easily accessible. Mclean was afforded an opportunity to perform the field sobriety tests which were performed to standard. A short time later Mclean confessed that he did not have a prescription for the narcotic. Mclean was advised that he was under arrest and was placed into handcuffs. Mclean was transported to Middletown Police HQ for processing. Arrangements were made for the vehicle to be retrieved at a later time and date. The suspected narcotic was confirmed to be in fact Percocet 325/5mg by their identifier markings.


Mclean was charged with violation of C.G.S. 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics. Mclean was released on a \$500 dollar non-surety bond with a court date of October 27, 2016 at Middletown GA9.

REMARKS

On 10/26/2016, at approximately 1615 hours I, Officer Foster, was dispatched to 118 Newfield Street on the report of a dispute between a Direct TV employee and a resident. The resident had allegedly ran over some safety cones set up by the employee after refusing to wait for them to be moved. The resident has since gone inside to his apartment (3R). On arrival, I met with the complainant, [redacted] who was set up in the rear of the building. [redacted] stated he was installing a service for the apartment complex and had marked the area off with cones due to the fact he was on a ladder. [redacted] explained while he was on his ladder working on the service, a light green Nissan Altima, operated by an older white male, pulled around the corner at a high rate of speed.

[redacted] stated he was in the process of coming down from the ladder so he could move the safety cones so the operator could pass freely. [redacted] stated that the operator became impatient and drove over two of the cones at a high rate of speed and continued to the end of the lot. The male operator then exited his vehicle and was getting ready to go inside.

[redacted] stated he asked the male why he couldn't wait and pointed out there was still a safety cone stuck under his vehicle. The male then proceeded to tell [redacted] "Fuck you get your own cone" and went inside his apartment. [redacted] stated he feared the male would retaliate against him if he attempted to remove the cone based on his aggressive attitude.


I attempted to make contact with the operator at his apartment (3R). The male answered the door and was identified as

Mark Pitruzzello by his Connecticut Driver's License. I asked Pitruzzello what happened and why he could not wait for to move his cones. Pitruzzello stated he didn't have time to wait and was short with his answers. I explained to Pitruzzello that his actions were unacceptable and I would be issuing him an infraction for causing a disturbance. I asked Pitruzzello if he could remove the cone from underneath his vehicle so it could be returned to . Pitruzzello was reluctant to do so at first and denied doing anything wrong. Pitruzzello reached under his vehicle and grabbed the cone and threw it in the direction of | who was waiting nearby. Having to remove the cone seemed to anger Pitruzzello and he stood up and stared at me without saying anything. Pitruzzello was clenching his fists and it appeared he wanted to fight. I told Pitruzzello to place his hands behind his back at which time I placed him in handcuffs. Pitruzzello was placed in the back of my cruiser and was transported to Middletown Police HQ for processing.

Pitruzzello was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-181 Breach of Peace 2nd and was released on a \$500 non-surety bond. Pitruzzello was given a court date of November 09, 2016 at 0900 hours at Middletown GA9.


