

**REMARKS**

On Friday, 10/22/16 at approximately 2305 hours, I, Officer Jeffries responded to 308 Main Street Extension (CVS) for a report of a larceny.

I spoke with the CVS store manager, [redacted] who stated two women walked into the store at approximately 2200 hours and immediately went over to the shampoo aisle. One woman, who was later identified as [redacted], began taking shampoo off of the store shelf and placing the bottles on the ground. The other female, who was later identified as Sara Grimes, was walking around at the end of the aisles. I then observed [redacted] take approximately ten (10) shampoo bottles and place them into her backpack. I observed Sara and [redacted] walk out of CVS without paying for the shampoo at approximately 2213 hours. [redacted] stated the value of the shampoo was approximately \$120.00.

[redacted] stated on behalf of CVS, he would like to press criminal charges against the two females.

provided me with a copy of the surveillance video for evidence.

I observed Sara standing on the corner of Main Street and Green Street. I approached Sara and she admitted she was with [redacted] in CVS when [redacted] put the shampoo bottles in her backpack. Sara stated she was looking out for employees and other patrons so [redacted] would not get caught. Sara was very cooperative and provided me with [redacted] s full name.


Sara was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Department. While at Middletown Police Department, Sara stated [redacted] was going to be sleeping at a campsite near River Road. Sara provided me with directions on how to get to the campsite.

Sara was processed and charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-125b, Larceny Sixth Degree. Sara was released on a non-surety \$500.00 bond. Sara is scheduled to appear at Middletown Superior Court, GA-09, on Wednesday, 11/02/16 at 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On Sunday October 23, 2016 at approximately 1639 hours I was dispatched to Rite Aid located at 10 Main Street for a report of a disturbance among a group of juveniles.

The caller, "Victim 1" stated she had been threatened by Cam'ron Williams with a knife. Victim 1 stated she had been hanging out with her friend "juvenile 1" inside of the corridor next to Rite Aid and they were supposed to meet up with more people. Victim 1 stated the issue with Williams started because he showed up with "juvenile 2" whom she had been in a physical fight with in the past. Juvenile 2 had brought her friend "juvenile 3" with her as well. Victim 1 stated she did not feel comfortable around Juvenile 2 and this caused an issue. Victim 1 said juvenile 3 got in her face and was giving her a hard time about not wanting to hang out with juvenile 2. Victim 1 said it seemed like it was going to turn into a fight, when she saw Williams pull out a knife and start waving it around at her. Victim 1 said Williams told her he would stab her with the knife. Victim 1 feared for her safety so she ran outside and called the Police. Victim 1 provided me with a sworn written statement detailing the incident and advised me she wanted Williams arrested.


After conducting my investigation surrounding this incident, I went to 48 Stoneycrest Drive in an effort to locate Williams. I spoke to his mother first and explained the situation to her. I got

Williams for me and I began questioning him about the incident. Williams stated he had nothing to do with the incident and it was between the juveniles and the victim. Williams admitted to having the knife out, but stated he had not threatened to stab Victim 1. Williams stated he was simply holding the knife in his hand. I explained to Williams that it was a bad idea to carry a knife around in his hand in public, especially on Main Street. I advised Williams that I had a sworn statement documenting what had happened, as well as the verbal statements of witnesses who had seen him with the knife, including an unbiased witness.


Due to the circumstances and the description of the events given to me by several people, Williams was issued misdemeanor summons #MC379737. Williams was charged with Breach of Peace 2nd degree (53a-181) and is due in court on November 04, 2016 at GA9 at 0900 hours.
