

**REMARKS**

On 10-28-2016 Detectives from the Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit, assisted by members of the Patrol Division and CT Parole Officers prepared to execute a signed narcotics search and seizure warrant on the person of Ernest Crump, and 42 Saint Johns Street Unit 1 Middletown, Connecticut. It should be noted that 42 Saint Johns Street is within 1500' of McDonough Elementary School. The measurement is 1020.15 feet which is documented on a map attached to this case file.

This search warrant was obtained as a result of a narcotics investigation in which Crump was observed by members of the Middletown Narcotics Unit conducting a sale of narcotics from his residence of 42 Saint Johns Street Unit 1.

CT Parole Officers scheduled a home visit with Crump at 0900 hours. MPD Narcotics Detectives along with CT Parole Officers went to the above address to meet with Crump.

At approximately 0910 hours, after Crump was secured, Detectives, CT Parole Officers, and uniformed patrol officers proceeded to 42 Saint Johns Street Unit 1. We announced our presence and intent to serve a signed search and seizure warrant. After several seconds of no one answering the door, and feeling that those inside may either be hiding, attempting to destroy evidence, or attempting to retrieve weapons to use against police, we entered the residence through the

unlocked rear door. Once inside the apartment we conducted a room by room search for occupants but no occupants were located inside. Once the residence was secured Detectives began a thorough search of the apartment and the outside porch area. The following items were found:

On the porch area on a shelf approximately three feet from the rear entrance door by Detective Lathrop:

1. 6 individual baggies of suspected marijuana in a shoe (total weight 28.4 grams)
2. 3 individual baggies of suspected marijuana in a shoe (total weight 14.8 grams)
3. 1 baggie of suspected marijuana (total weight 2 grams)
4. 1 black digital scale with suspected marijuana residue
5. Unused plastic sealable baggies typically used to package various amounts of illicit narcotics
6. Torn plastic baggies and used plastic baggies

On the porch in a dryer under the controls the following items were located by Detective Peck and Sgt. Yepes:

1. Heat sealed baggie of suspected marijuana (total weight of 59.10 grams)
2. Baggie of suspected crack cocaine (total weight of 3.0 grams)

In Crump's bedroom the following items were located:

1. 1 baggie of suspected marijuana (total weight 2.2 grams) on the desk located by Detective Dirga
2. 1 partially burnt marijuana cigarette (total weight .5 grams) in ashtray on desk located by Detective Dirga.
3. Black and silver Iphone on the desk located by Detective Dirga
4. Proof of residency (Mail) on the desk in the name of Ernest Crump (42 Saint Johns Street Unit 1 and 2) by Detective Dirga.
5. Nexus Tablet on the floor of Crump's bedroom
6. \$274.00 US currency in a metal box on the desk located by Detective Dirga

In the driveway next to the stairway and the shelf and dryer where the suspected marijuana and suspected crack cocaine was found Detective Peck located the white and grey scooter Crump was observed operating while conducting narcotics transactions. The scooter was seized for asset forfeiture and transported to MPD headquarters.

The digital scales and packaging material are commonly used by drug dealers to take large amounts of drugs and break them down to smaller amounts for sales. The drugs packaged for sale, coupled with these materials, made it evident that Crump was directly involved in the sale of crack cocaine and marijuana.

Detective Dirga weighed the marijuana seized from the apartment and from outside the apartment using the department issued scale. The total weight of the marijuana seized was 107 grams. Detective Peck tested the marijuana seized using NARK kit 10008 which tested positive for the presence of THC.

The street value of the marijuana in Crump's possession was determined to be \$1605.00 if sold at \$15 per gram.

Detective Dirga weighed the suspected crack cocaine on the department scale which weighed 3.0 grams. Detective Dirga tested the suspected crack cocaine using NARK kit 10013 which tested positive for crack. The street value of the 3.0 grams of crack cocaine was deemed to be \$300.00 if sold at \$10 per .1 gram.

Given contraband found in Crump's apartment and directly outside of Crump's apartment and by conducting controlled narcotic purchases from Crump, it was evident that he was illegally possessing and selling crack cocaine and marijuana.


Crump was transported to the Middletown Police Department by a marked MPD patrol unit for processing.


Once back at MPD headquarters Crump was advised of his Miranda Rights. Detective Peck fingerprinted, photographed and processed Crump in violation of CGS 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics, 21a-278(b) Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell, 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of a Controlled Substance, and 21a-278a(b) Possession with intent to sell(School Zone).

Crump is currently on Parole and is supervised by a Parole Officer. Crump has 4 prior arrests with convictions of Possession of Narcotics, Carrying a Dangerous Weapon, Criminal Weapon Possession, Failure to Appear, Possession of Marijuana, and Probation Violation.

Crump was held on a \$150,000 cash or surety bond in violation of 2 counts of 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of a controlled substance, 21a-267(a) Possession of drug paraphernalia, 21a-277(b) possession of marijuana with intent to sell, 21a-277(b) Possession of narcotics with intent to sell, and 21a-278(a)(b) Possession with intent to sell in a school zone.

Crump was held in a MPD holding cell and is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 10-31-2016 at 0900 hours.

**REMARKS**

On 10/16/16 at approximately 2014 hrs, I, Officer Tiano, was on patrol in a marked patrol vehicle in the area of Washington Street and High Street. At this time, I was traveling east bound on Washington Street, west of High Street, in the far right lane of travel, stopped in traffic.

While stopped in traffic, I saw a vehicle turn west bound on to Washington Street, off of High Street at a high rate of speed. I could see the vehicle lean to the passengers side indicating it was making this turn at a high rate of speed. I could hear this vehicles engine rev loudly and as it passed me, the vehicle's tires began to squeal indicating they were losing traction. Due to the sound of the engine revving and the tires squealing, it sounded as if the operator was shifting gears rapidly. This constituted the offense of C.G.S. 14-218a Traveling Unreasonably Fast.

The vehicle, which was later determined to be a green 1998 Toyota Tacoma bearing CT. Combination

registration C031408 continued to traveling at a high rate of speed to the area of Prospect Street and Liberty Street where I conducted a motor vehicle stop of this vehicle. The vehicle suddenly turned into the driveway of 63 Prospect Street where the operator immediately exited the vehicle, disobeyed all verbal commands to stay in the vehicle and attempted to flee the scene by walking into his residence. The operator was later identified as the accused, Roshane Sterling. The accused had refused to obey commands to put his hands behind his back, tensed his body, balled his fists and attempted to pull away from me, resisting being placed in handcuffs. He was eventually placed into handcuffs and taken into custody.

At the conclusion of this investigation, the accused was charged with violation C.G.S. 14-218a Traveling Unreasonably Fast and the offense of C.G.S. 53a-167a Interfering with an Officer. He was transported to Police Headquarters where he was booked, photograph and fingerprinted. He was issued a \$5,000 non-surety bond and a court date of 10/31/16 at Middletown Superior Court G.A. 9. He was later released.

**REMARKS**

On 10/18/16 at approximately 1750hrs I (Officer Wasilewski) was stopped at the red traffic light on Rapallo Avenue by Main Street. As I was stopped I heard the loud after market exhaust revving high and a vehicle shifting from gear to gear as it accelerated. I then observed a red Honda 2 door vehicle (bearing Indian Registration IU7233) traveling northbound on Main Street. The Honda made an abrupt right turn into the empty parking stall area on Main Street and attempt to pass a silver Honda Accord by traveling northbound in the empty parking stalls. As the red Honda passed the Accord it immediately slammed on its brakes and slid approximately 20-30 feet before approaching the intersection where I was parked.

The red Honda turned right and pulled into the no parking area on the corner of Rapallo and Main Street. I activated my overhead emergency lights and made a U-turn with my marked Police cruiser as I pulled behind the vehicle. I positioned my cruiser so that the vehicle could not back out of the parking spot. The red Honda was in between a vehicle in front of it and my cruiser behind it. The operator of the red Honda (later identified as Luis Ruiz) put his vehicle in reverse, revved the engine, and backed into my Police Cruiser. I radioed for a backup Officer to respond to my location then exited my cruiser. I approached the Honda and ordered Ruiz to step out of the vehicle, face the inside, and place his hands behind his back. Ruiz did as I directed. Due to the uncertainty if he had been involved in some sort of crime and the fact that he appeared to be attempting to flee as a backed into my vehicle, he was detained in handcuffs.

After running Ruiz's license through central dispatch I was informed that his license was valid. The vehicle registration was run and no record was found. Ruiz was also unable to provide a valid insurance card. Officer Mazzotta allowed Ruiz to park the vehicle in the nearby parking lot.

Ruiz was issued a misdemeanor summons (MC 379904) for violation of CSG 14-222 Reckless Driving, 14-233 Passing on Right, 14-12a\* Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and 14-13 No Vehicle Insurance. He was issued a court date of 11/2/16 at 0900hrs and told he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time. He stated he understood. Nothing further.



**REMARKS**

On 10/29/16 at approximately 1829hrs Officer Terrible and I (Officer Wasilewski) were dispatched to the area of the Forest City Liquor Store (610 Main Street) for a reported assault. The caller stated the victim (hereby referred to as Victim 1 or V1) was assaulted and suffered an injury to his face which had occurred in the area of Ferry Street by the bar. The suspect had thrown a brick at the victims face causing a laceration then fled the area. Officer Stroud informed be that V1 had suffered a laceration to the right side of his face from a piece of concrete or asphalt that was used to hit him with. He told me that V1's girlfriend (Suspect 1 or S1) assaulted him and would be under arrest for assault if she was located.


A short time later, S1 was located on Ferry Street. S1 stated "I always get blamed for everything. I didn't do it. It was somebody else." I asked S1 who assaulted V1 if it was not her but she was unable to provide an answer. S1 also declined to provide a voluntary sworn written statement.

Officer Stroud stated V1 explained that he was in the alleyway in between Fangs and 80 Ferry with S1. S1 was waiting for someone so V1 asked S1 for her keys to her apartment. S1 told him "no" at which time V1 got angry. V1 stated he swore at her and spit in her direction on the ground. V1 then walked away and sat on the curb. As he was sitting on the curb S1 walked up behind him and hit him in the face with a large piece of asphalt curbing which was in the alley way. V1 stated he was knocked to the ground and nearly unconscious. S1 then walked away from V1 as he layed on the sidewalk. V1 stated he got up while his face was bleeding and walked onto Main Street until he found someone he knew that could call the Police. V1 told Officer Stroud that S1 has a history of injuring him and had stabbed him in the past due to domestic violence. The voluntary sworn written statement was submitted with the case documents. Two photographs of V1's injury to the right side of his face were also submitted with the case documents.


V1 was placed under arrest and brought to the Middletown Police Department where she was read her rights, processed, photographed, and fingerprinted. She was charged with violation of CGS 53a-61 Assault 3rd Degree and 53a-181 Breach of Peace. She was assigned a next day court date of Monday 10/31/16 at 0900hrs. She was told she would appear at the GA 9 court house on that date and time.

It should be noted that V1 has several incidents involving assault to S1 as well as 51 prior arrests with convictions for similar charges including Assault 1st Degree, Assault 2nd Degree, Assault 3rd Degree, Robbery 1st Degree, Robbery 2nd Degree, Robbery 3rd Degree, Criminal Weapons Possession, Prostitution, Possession of Narcotics, Burglary, and Violations of Protective Orders.

Victim #1 stated that Wilcznski continued to yell, scream and threaten to kill her because she was not a good mother until the police showed up. Victim #1 stated that she was in fear for her life and was scared of Wilcznski. .

Wilcznski was transported to MPD for booking and processing. Wilcznski was read his rights, processed, charged with Threatening 2nd 53a-62, Disorderly Conduct 53a-182, held on a \$5000.00 dollars Surety bond, placed into cell #3 and given a court date of 10/31/2016.

Case closed.
