REMARKS

On 9/2/16 at 2213 hours, I, Officer Remotti, responded to Middlesex Hospital Emergency Department located at 28 Crescent Street for a out of control patient.

Upon arrival, I was directed by hospital staff to room 2 where I found a male patient, later identified as James Eirich sitting in the bed speaking with staff attempting to keep him calm.

According to a staff member in charge of Eirich 's care Eirich was being discharged from the hospital at about 2210 hours after being medically cleared. During this time, Eirich became aggressive and combative toward staff including , and made threats to physically harm them. Eirich refused to listen to instruction of staff and became enraged when asked to sit in his bed. As Eirich continued to escalate, he flipped over a hospital bed over.causing staff to became immediately concerned for their safety as well as the safety of all the other patients. Security was called and Eirich was held down by them until he calmed down. His verbal aggression toward staff continued until police arrived.

Based on the above facts and circumstances which were documented in a sworn written statement, Eirich was placed in handcuffs and advised he was under arrest. He was transported to police headquarters without incident where he was placed in a processing area and removed from handcuffs. Eirich was

advised of his rights at 2231 hours, was photographed, fingerprinted and processed under UAR# 8873446. He was charged with Breach of Peace 2nd Degree; 53a-181 in violation of C.G.S and released on a \$500 non-surety bond after being issued a G.A. -9 court appearance date of 9/16/16 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On Wednesday, September 7th, 2016 at 9:38 pm, Sgt. Bartolotta and Officers Stroud, St. Peter and I, Officer Ortiz responded to in front of Los Primos grocery store located at 656 Main Street Middletown on an assault complaint. The caller, who wants to be anonymous is reporting that a tall black male wearing black shorts and a gray tee shirt is assaulting a black female dressed in a pink shirt outside the store. Due to the nature of the call, the aforementioned officers responded with lights and sirens.

On arrival, we observed a tall black male fitting the caller's description riding a pedal bike in front of the store. He was identified as, _____ and detained.

Officer Bloom and I were allowed to viewed the stores (Los Primos) video surveillance. The video was played back for us by the store owner starting from 9 pm until police arrived. The video showed speaking with a female wearing a pink blouse in front of the store. The video clearly showed no disturbance or fight.

After determining that no crime was committed, _____ was allowed to leave. Sgt. Bartolotta informed me that the caller was Cherina S. Watson, _____ ex-girlfriend. _____ said that he was in front of Los Primos talking with Cherina just before we (police) arrived, but that he didn't hit her or nothing like that. _____ is

currently on probation.

I, Officer Ortiz contacted central dispatch to verify if the call came in via 9-1-1 and it did.

A short time later, I made contact with Cherina by phone. When I explained to Cherina that I viewed the video from the store and that there was no assault or fight she recanted her statement. Cherina admitted that she lied because ... had owed her \$20 and that she was upset about the money. Cherina said she wanted to get ... in trouble because she knew he was on probation.

I informed Cherina that she needed to turn herself in to police for reporting an assault that didn't occurred.

A short time later, she did. Cherina was issued an MSC for misuse of emergency 9-1-1 system under CGS 53a-180d. She was assigned a court date of 09/20/16 to appear at GA9 at 9 am.

REMARKS

On 9/9/2016, at approximately 2156 hours, Detective Lemieux and I were stopped on Stony Crest Drive at Newfield Street. I observed a blue BMW, bearing CT registration AE96630, traveling northbound on Newfield Street. The vehicle did not have its rear license plate illuminated in violation of 14-96c.

The driver's rear passenger did said he did not have any identification. He told me his name was .

I ran his name and dispatch said they could not find any information on such a person. He claimed that he had a Connecticut identification card. I know if he had an identification card it would be located by dispatch by running his name and date of birth, so it was evident that he was not [redacted]. As we spoke I could detect the distinct odor of marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle. I was able to identify the odor through my training and experience.

I had the unidentified male exit the vehicle and patted him down and discovered he had no identification, but felt what I was immediately able to identify through my training and experience as a baggie of marijuana in his right shorts pocket. I removed a baggie of suspected marijuana from the pocket. I told the male I knew he was not [redacted] and told him if he told me who he really was, he would not get any further charges. The male then told me he was [redacted].

I have personally arrested [redacted] in the past and know that he is not [redacted]. When I told him this he finally admitted that he was Tramaine Goforth. A check through dispatch revealed that Goforth had an active arrest warrant for violation of a protective order and disorderly conduct.

The driver was given a verbal warning for 14-96c Failure to Illuminate Plate and was released.


Goforth was transported to the Middletown Police Department, where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed.

The suspected marijuana tested positive with NARK 8. The baggie of marijuana later weighed 4.9 grams on a department scale.





REMARKS

On 09/09/16, at approximately 1705 hours, Officer Milardo and I, Officer DiFonzo, were dispatched to a location in Middletown CT for fight complaint.

Upon arrival Officers met with the Witness who stated on 09/09/16, around 1700 hours, he was inside his apartment when he heard yelling and banging coming from the apartment above his. The Witness stated he walked upstairs to the third floor apartment and observed the front door open. The Witness stated he then observed Victim/Offender #1 run out of the apartment and stand in the hallway. The Witness stated Victim/Offender #1, who he did not know, told him to call the police. Victim/Offender #1 stated she observed Victim/Offender #2, who is her husband, walk by her on the sidewalk. Victim/Offender #1 stated Victim/Offender #2 asked her if she wanted walk to his residence to pick up her belongings and she agreed.

Victim/Offender #1 stated shortly thereafter she walked up to Vicim/Offender #2's residence and began picking up boxes containing her belongings in the hallway. Victim/Offender #1 stated Victim/Offender#2 began arguing with her about her ex-boyfriend. Victim/Offender #1 stated Victim/Offender #2 asked to hold her cell phone and she handed it to him so he could read her social media messages. Victim/Offender #1 stated Victim/Offender #2 then picked up a hammer and hit it several times causing it to break. Victim/Offender #1 stated Victim/Offender #2 then threw her cell phone at the inside wall of his apartment and she picked it up.

Officers did not observe any signs of physical injuries on Victim/Offender #1. Victim/Offender #1 stated her 64 Gigabit gold colored Iphone 6 Plus is valued at \$600.


There was an active Protective Order between Victim/Offender #1 and Victim/Offender #2 with both being the protected person and the defendant.




REMARKS



Gracia appeared to be abnormally nervous and stated that the two were spending, "quality time together" in the open grass area. As our conversation continued, I noticed Gracia continuously reaching into his right pocket. After the third or fourth time, I asked Gracia if he had anything on him that I needed to be aware of. Gracia replied that he had a knife in his right pocket. I told Gracia to refrain from reaching into that pocket before telling him I was going to remove it for my safety. While I was reaching into his right pant pocket, I observed a small plastic baggie sticking out from his inner most pocket. I inquired about what was in the baggie and Gracia stated, "nothing". Suspecting that there was illegal contraband within the baggie, I removed it for closer inspection. I observed the baggie which contained two wax glassine baggies which contained a brownish powder. Gracia identified the substance as heroin.

Gracia was advised that he was under arrest and was placed in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness. Gracia was transported to Middletown Police HQ to be processed and booked for the charge. The suspected heroin was field tested at Police HQ utilizing NARK kit #3 which yielded positive

presumptive results for heroin. In addition, the suspected heroin was tested with NARK kit #20033 which yielded positive presumptive results for Fentanyl presence.

Gracia was charged with violation of G.G.S. 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics. Gracia was released on a \$1,500 non-surety bond and was issued a court date of September 21, 2016 at 0900 hours at Middlesex Superior Court. The suspected heroin was submitted to evidence and a JDRC-18 form was completed.

REMARKS

On 9/4/16 at approximately 2232hrs Officer Tiano and I (Officer Wasilewski) observed a white Nissan Maxima (bearing CT registration 2AWER3) parked at the Gulf Gas Station at 339 South Main Street. The vehicle pulled out onto Pameacha Ave with the lights still not illuminated. Soon after the operator turn on its high beam lights. The white Maxima made two turns without signal for the turn. The Maxima also crossed over into the left side of the road on one occasion. Officer Tiano and I continued to follow the vehicle to determine if he was operating under the influence.

The operator of the vehicle turned onto the Arrigoni Bridge and proceeded eastbound toward Portland. As we were following behind the maxima, our speedometer registered 55mph in the 35mph zone. I activated


our emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop on the Portland side of the bridge. Upon making contact with the operator, later identified as Kortyze Cruz, he explained that his headlights were not working and he was waiting on new ones. He stated he was aware that it was "a bad idea" to be driving without any functioning headlights. He stated he used his high beams when cars weren't around.


As I spoke with Cruz I noticed what appeared to be a fine amount of marijuana in the floor mat of the driver seat area. Cruz stated "it might be weed" and admitted to smoking marijuana in the past. He also explained that he was "arrested for burglary about a week ago". He was asked out of the vehicle and subsequently admitted to having a knife on him. The knife in his pocket was a metal handle spring loaded/assisted folding pocket knife with a knife blade 3" in length. The metal blade quickly opened from the spring assist when a small lever was pushed, in violation of CGS 53-206.

A search of the vehicle revealed two of the same knives located in the center console. Both were metal handle folding pocket knives with a 3" spring assisted blade. Additionally, I found a collapsible baton in the center console as well as an electronic defense weapon (Taser type device) under the passenger front seat. Cruz stated they were all his and he "just liked to collect weapons" because it was his hobby. The two knives, collapsible baton, and electronic defense weapon (taser) found in the vehicle are each considered Weapons in a Motor according to Connecticut General Statutes (CGS 29-38).

Furthermore, a search of the trunk of the vehicle revealed two BB gun rifles. Both BB gun rifles were seized and tagged for safe keeping due to Cruz's vehicle being towed from the scene. The two BB gun rifles, three knives, collapsible baton, and electronic defense weapon were all tagged and placed in Middletown Police evidence locker #7.

Cruz was placed under arrest for violation of CGS 29-38 Weapon in a Motor Vehicle (4- counts), 53-206(a) Carrying a Dangerous Weapon, 14-218a Traveling Unreasonably Fast, 14-236 Failure to Drive in Proper Lane, 14-244 Failure to Signal, 14-96a(a) Failure to Have Headlights, and 14-96u Improper Use of High Beams. He was release on a \$5,000 Surety Bond and assigned a court date of 9/19/2016 at 0900hrs. He was told he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time.

REMARKS

On September 12, 2016 at approximately 2004, Central Dispatch received a complaint regarding the larceny of a Huffy 10-speed from 988 Washington Street, apartment 137.

~~At approximately 0713 hours on September 12, 2016, I, Officer Spedding and Officer Magnano were~~ dispatched to a suspicious person complaint in the area of South Plumb Street and East Street. (Case #16-22540) I located an individual walking across East Street, and halfway up the driveway of 63 East Street. The party was dressed in a red jacket, navy pants with a stripe on the side, matching the description given by the caller. He was identified by his CT Driver's License (017779062) as Antonio Hill (1/14/85). When Officers conducted a patdown on Hill, he was in possession of a large amount of spare change. He stated he was heading to Price Chopper, but stopped to use the woods at this residence for a bathroom. Hill was sent on his way, advised to stay out of people's yards, and walked from the scene. Hill is known by Officer Magnano for entering motor vehicles and taking spare change.

Approximately 35 minutes later, I observed Hill riding a black mountain bike, East on Washington Street towards Price Chopper. Due to the fact Hill was not riding a bike when we initially had contact, I attempted to catch up to him, to question the acquisition of the bike. I located the bike Hill was riding, in front of Price Chopper. I pulled my police vehicle to a better location, in order to wait for Hill to exit Price Chopper. In the time I drove around the building, Hill had exited Price Chopper and left on the bike. I notified Officer Kraeger, who was in route to assist me, to be on the lookout for Hill. Hill was located at approximately 450 Washington Street, by Officer Kraeger.

During a search of Hill, he was in possession of a clear pipe-like tube, with burnt residue and a burnt filter inside. Through my training and experience, this type of pipe is synonymous with smoking crack.

While speaking with Hill, a complaint came in of a male party, earlier in the day had been seen going up a driveway on East Street and entering a Honda Accord. (Case # 16-22547) This incident had been witnessed by a neighbor, who gave a detailed clothing description of the party. The neighbor was driving when she saw the male in the vehicle. She turned her vehicle around and was able to take a photo of the same male, who was now walking South on East St. The male party in the photo was wearing the exact same clothing at Hill. Officer Sanford responded to East Street and spoke with the victim. No items were missing from the vehicle. The picture was submitted to evidence.

The bike photographed by Officer Kraeger and returned to the larceny victim. The pipe was submitted for destruction.

It is believed that while Hill was walking South on East Street, he was going from house to house, checking car doors to see if they were open. If found open, he would take the change, which is why we found him with a pocket full earlier in the day. At this time, no victims have come forward reporting a larceny from a motor vehicle.

Antonio Hill is charged with violating C.G.S. 53a-110a Simple Trespass (2 counts), 53a-103 Burglary 3rd Degree, 53a-125b Larceny 6th Degree, 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Hill is being held on a \$10,000 surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA9 on 9/12/16 at 0900 hours.
