

**REMARKS**

On 9-5-16, at or about 2138 hrs, I was traveling north on DeKoven Drive, near Green Street, when I observed a vehicle, traveling south on DeKoven Drive, with no head lights on. The vehicle passed me and I noticed that it did not have any tail lights activated.

I conducted a U-turn at the intersection of DeKoven and Green, and pulled behind the vehicle at the intersection of DeKoven and Washington Street. I activated my emergency lights and siren, as the vehicle was turning west onto Washington Street. The vehicle pulled into a driveway in the area of 32 Washington Street. I illuminated the vehicle with my spot light and I could see that the driver was shifting in his seat and disappeared from view, several times. The vehicle was a Ford Freestyle, bearing CT registration plate 772UPR.

I approached the drivers side of the vehicle and made contact with the driver. I asked him for his license, registration and proof of insurance. The male said he did not have a license because it was suspended. He gave his name, John Forline. I recognized Forline through past police encounters. There was also a female in the vehicle in the front passenger seat.

As I began to interact with Forline, he continued to reach around the vehicles interior and then started reaching into his pockets. I told him to stop reaching into his pockets and around the vehicle and he apologized and stopped. I asked him whose vehicle it was and he said that it was " ". I asked her where she was from and he responded, "Middletown." Forline then began to reach around the vehicle again and again, started reaching into his pockets.

I then, asked Forline to step out of the vehicle, which he did, without protest. Forline appeared overly nervous, his eyes were darting back and forth, he was evasive with his answers, his voice was trembling, and he had trouble focusing on my questions. I asked Forline if he had anything dangerous on his person and he said, "No." I asked him if I could check and he said that I could search him. No contraband or weapons were discovered. I asked Forline if there was anything in the vehicle that shouldn't be there. He stammered and then said that there was a "butterfly knife," in the center console. At this time, the female passenger, was still seated in the passenger seat of the vehicle, she had direct access to the knife. I approached the vehicle from the drivers side and Officer Wasilewski, who was now on scene, approached from the passenger side. I asked the female to step out of the vehicle and I reached into the center console compartment of the vehicle. I then saw a black drop or butterfly style knife. I also saw glass pipe, with burnt ends, and copper wiring pushed into one end. On the copper wiring were ashes. I recognized the item, through my training and experience as a police officer as pipe commonly used for smoking crack cocaine.

I search of the vehicle revealed a glass cup in a back pack, located on the driver's side rear passenger seat of the vehicle. The glass had white residue on it, which tested positive for the presence of cocaine using NARK NIK Wipe. Forline claimed ownership of the back pack but claimed her had no idea why the residue on the glass would test positive for cocaine. A quarter was located in the drivers side door. The quarter had white residue on it, which tested positive for cocaine, using NARK NIK Wipe. The residue on the suspected crack pipe was collected and tested positive for cocaine using NARK test kit 4.

The butterfly knife was collected, along with all the narcotics materials. While speaking with / and Forline, Forline claimed ownership of all the items, verbally stating that / had no knowledge of the items in the vehicle.

Forline was arrested. He was brought to Middletown Police Headquarters to be processed. He was charged with the following:

- Operating a MV with suspended license 14-215 (License was suspended 8/3/2016)
- Failure to have lights lit 14-96a(a)
- Possession of drug paraphernalia 21-267(a)
- Possession of narcotics 21-279(a)
- Weapon in a motor vehicle 29-38

Forline was assigned a court date of 9-16-16 and released on a \$5000 non-surety bond.



Nelson was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters and processed for the charge of 53a-125a - Larceny 5th degree and an active [redacted] warrant.

Nelson was held on a \$5,000 surety bond with a court date of 9/15/2016 0900hrs at Middletown Superior Court.
