
REMARKS

REMARKS

On Saturday 09/17/2016 at 0009 hours, I, Det. Peck, was dispatched to a reported domestic disturbance at an address in Middletown. The caller, Victim #1, stated her boyfriend, Javier Crespo, was intoxicated inside her apartment trying to hit her. Sgt. Scirpo and Off. D'Aresta also responded.

Upon my arrival I was met by Victim #1 and her mother on the porch. Victim #1 stated Javier arrived drunk and was clearly upset. She stated he began yelling at her in regards to cheating on him. She stated he continued screaming and attempted to hit her, causing her mother to get in between them and push him away from her.

Upon entering the apartment, I observed several juvenile children, later identified as *Juvenile Victim #1* (6 years old), *Juvenile Victim #2* (3 years old) and *Juvenile Victim #3* (2 years old), peeking out from a doorway next to the front door. I also observed a picture frame lying face down in the kitchen. As I was walking towards the bedroom, Javier exited

the room and began walking towards me. I asked Javier to explain what had happened and he responded, "If you want to talk to me, we are gonna go outside and talk man to man." As he spoke, I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath.

I again asked him what had occurred and he responded by yelling that he not going to talk about inside the house. I then pointed to the picture frame on the floor and asked him how it got there. Javier yelled that he lost his temper and "shit happened."

Victim #1 stated that Javier began yelling at her while the they were standing in the doorway between the kitchen and living room. She stated while they were arguing Javier raised his hand to hit her and was only stopped because her mother stepped in and caught his arm. Victim #1 stated Javier pulled away from her mother causing her to stumble backwards into the picture frame and knock it to the ground. Victim #1 stated the juveniles had been sitting on the couch in the living room. It should be noted that the couch is located approximately 5 feet from the doorway where the adults had been involved and that any physical fight between the adults presented a serious risk to the children's safety.

Javier stated to me that he was upset with Victim #1 because he believed she was cheating on him. Javier stated he came home drunk and angry and "couldn't keep it inside."

He stated the two argued in the doorway but he never hit her. Javier stated that during the scuffle, he caused Victim #1's mother to fall back into the picture frame, which knocked it from the wall. He acknowledged that their (3) children had been seated in the living room, in the immediate area, and that it was not something they should have witnessed, however he stated "I had no choice, what would you do as a man?"


Based on the investigation, Javier was placed under arrest. He was transported to Middletown Police HQ where he was read his rights, which he acknowledged in writing, fingerprinted and photographed.

Javier Crespo was charged with violations of;
-CGS 53a-182 - Disorderly Conduct
-CGS 53-21 - Risk of Injury to a Minor (3 counts)

He was released after posting a \$10,000.00 Surety bond, through In and Out Bail Bonds, and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, of 09/19/2016 at 0900 hours.

Prior to leaving Javier was issued a Conditions of Release which stated he was to have no contact with Victim #1 or their (3) mutual children until such time as the court advised him otherwise. Javier stated he understood the instructions and would have no contact.

REMARKS

On 09/17/2016 at approximately 23:53 hour I, Officer Austin Smith was dispatched to an apartment on Ferry Street for a complaint of an unwanted person. The victim told emergency dispatchers that her ex-boyfriend Walter Dismuke was kicking her door and trying to break into her apartment.

When officers arrived on scene, Dismuke was seen kicking the door to the apartment. Officer Schreiner took Dismuke into custody without incident and placed him in the back seat of this officer's patrol vehicle. I then transported Dismuke to police headquarters where he was processed on domestic charges.

Officer Schreiner remained on scene and spoke to the victim. The victim stated that she did not wish to give a statement against Dismuke, and only wanted him to leave her alone. Officer Schreiner stated that he observed damage to the victim's door caused by Dismuke kicking it. The cost to repair the damage is believed to exceed \$100.00 in value.



REMARKS

On 9/18/16 at approximately 1947 hours I responded to a Middletown address to investigate the report of a physical domestic dispute.

Upon arrival I spoke with the victim of the dispute, hereinafter referred to as V1. V1 stated that the dispute had just happened inside the apartment of her boyfriend Brandon Cooper and that after the dispute she had walked to her mother's residence to contact police. It should be noted these two residences are in close proximity to each other.

V1 stated that she and Cooper have been in an on again, off again dating relationship for approximately the past twelve years and that the two have been involved in multiple physical domestic disputes in the past in which Cooper has assaulted her and been arrested. I was able to confirm through Middletown Police Department in house records that Cooper had been arrested for assaulting V1 dating back to August of 2013.

V1 stated that in the past she has had a protective or restraining order against Cooper but that currently the two do not have any orders. I verified that there are no active orders between the two. V1 stated that over the course of their relationship Cooper has assaulted her, threatened her, intimidated her, and has stabbed her in the back and slashed her face with a knife. V1 has a distinguishable scar on her left cheek which she stated had been the result of Cooper cutting her with a knife several years ago but that at the time she sought medical treatment but she lied and stated it was the result of being jumped by an unknown female in Hartford. She stated that she has protected Cooper in the past because she is scared of him and fearful of what he might do to her if she files complaints against him.

V1 stated that she and Cooper have been broken up but that in the past several months they have been trying to get back together and she had been spending time with him at his apartment on East Main Street. She stated that Cooper had not changed and he began to become physical with her so she again ended the relationship on or about 8/25/16. Middletown Police in house records show that on that date officers accompanied V1 at her request to Cooper's residence to get her belongings and leave without any further altercations between the two.

V1 stated that since that time Cooper has been contacting her and attempting to apologize and get her back. She stated that approximately three days ago she finally agreed to see Cooper again and drove to his residence. V1 stated that she has stayed at Cooper's residence for the past three days and has allowed him to utilize her vehicle to travel to and from work at a restaurant in Cromwell.

V1 stated that things between her and Cooper had been good until tonight. She stated that the two had been sleeping in his apartment and that Cooper had to go into work this evening. She stated that she believed he had to be to work at 6:00 or 7:00pm and that they had been taking a nap and woke up very late. She stated that upon waking up Cooper was extremely upset because he was going to be late for work and he began to yell at her as he gathered his belongings and got ready for work. V1 stated that she tried to reason with Cooper and tell him it was not her fault that they overslept. That made Cooper more angry and he approached her and began to push her. She stated that she yelled for him to stop at which time he punched her in the head with a closed fist as well as slapped her with an open fist. V1 stated that Cooper also began to accuse her of taking his "blunt" which he could not find so became more enraged when he believed she had stolen from him.

V1 stated she argued and stated she had not taken anything from him at which time Cooper picked up a plastic shower caddy and threw it at her striking her. Cooper then attacked her, pulled her hair, and grabbed her around the neck and started to strangle her as he pushed her down. As he did this he punched her in the head and face also with a closed fist. V1 stated that with Cooper choking her she could not breathe. She stated that she tried to getaway from Cooper and was trying to break free to run out of the apartment but that he kept a grip on her neck and she was unable to leave. V1 stated that due to Cooper strangling her with his hands and punching her she passed out momentarily. She stated that Cooper must have realized she was unconscious so let her neck go. She fell to the floor and upon regaining consciousness Cooper was standing next to her on the floor kneeling her in the ribs. V1 stated that he struck her with his knee extremely hard several times in the ribs before finally stopping. He then left her on the floor, took her car keys and left the residence in her vehicle to go to work.

V1 waited until Cooper was gone before walking to her mother's residence and calling police. V1's mother was out of state at the time.

While speaking with V1 she stated that she believed her ribs were broken. She stated that she had broken a rib in the past and that the feeling tonight was the same. V1 was having trouble taking deep breaths and was having a hard time moving. I observed that V1 had numerous fresh, red scratches and marks all over her neck, face, and chest area and to her right eye. She had red bruising on her shoulders and back as well as scrapes on her knees and legs. I also observed that V1 had red splotches and petechiae on her face and around her eyes, the result of broken blood capillaries, which would be consistent with her claims of being strangled so hard that she lost consciousness.

I immediately called for an ambulance and V1 was transported to Middlesex Hospital via Hunter's Ambulance. Once at the hospital photos of V1's injuries were taken. V1 also signed a Middlesex Hospital medical release form for all records associated with this incident. V1 declined to provide a written statement in regards to this incident citing fear of Cooper.

I had requested that Cromwell Police Department proceed to the restaurant and attempt to make contact with Cooper. I had not been advised that contact had been made yet however Cooper began to text V1 while I was speaking with her in the hospital questioning why the Middletown Police were looking for him. I learned that Cromwell PD had contacted Cooper and requested that he call the Middletown Police Department. I relayed this information back to central dispatch and advised that Cooper needed to be placed under arrest and requested that Cromwell PD return and locate him. MPD Officers also proceeded to the restaurant and arrived at the same time as Cromwell PD and located Cooper attempting to leave his work even though he had just recently arrived for his shift. Cooper was detained and placed under arrest. Officers relayed to me that a coworker of Cooper's, who was not identified, stated that he had just recently arrived at work and that after the initial Cromwell officer had spoke with Cooper and then left, Cooper immediately stated he had to leave work and attempted to leave before again being stopped in the parking lot.

Cooper was placed under arrested and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters to be processed. Cooper was not forthcoming with information. He stated that he had been with V1 in his residence and they had been asleep. Cooper stated that after waking up V1 began to accuse him of talking to other girls and began to argue with him about seeing his cell phone. Cooper stated that he immediately left to go to work and to prevent a further altercation and that nothing physical between him and V1 happened.

It should be noted that I initially began to question Cooper about a "dispute" he had with V1 and I never mentioned initially that she claimed it was physical in nature. Cooper cut me off and began to show me old scars on his fists stating that they were not from tonight and that they were old injuries to his hands. When I told him I had not said it was physical and I questioned why he was showing me his hands he just stated that he assumed that is what I had meant.

Cooper denied assaulting V1 and stated that he did not know how she got beat up but that maybe she had gone somewhere after he left for work and was assaulted there. Cooper did not express any concern for V1's condition when I advised him she had suffered injuries and was currently in the hospital.

Cooper was processed on the charges of assault 2 (53a-60), strangulation 2 (53a-64bb), and unlawful restraint 1 (53a-95) in violation of the CT General Statutes. He was held on a \$75,000 surety bond and issued a court date of 9/19/16 due to the domestic nature of the incident. Cooper is a convicted felon with multiple past domestic violence convictions on charges such as assault 3, violation of a protective order, probation violation, and failure to appear.






