REMARKS


On 9/7/2016, at approximately 1927 hours I, Officer Foster, was traveling Northbound on Main Street Extension in a marked Middletown Police Cruiser. Traveling in front of my vehicle was a black Acura Integra bearing CT registration 00BNYD. I had noticed prior in the day that the vehicle was not displaying a front

marker plate as required under C.G.S. 14-18(a). I activated my emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop for the violation. The vehicle pulled to the right and came to a complete stop. I approached the operator on the driver's side and identified him as Leshae Anderson by his Connecticut Driver's License.

I explained to Anderson my reasoning for stopping him and inquired whether or not he had the front marker plate. Anderson stated he had the plate at home and would put it in the window once he got home. A check with dispatch revealed that Anderson's license was suspended and was not to operate a motor vehicle. In addition, while I was speaking to Anderson I could smell the strong odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. I inquired whether Anderson was in possession of marijuana which he replied he wasn't. A search of the vehicle revealed a small amount of marijuana located in a book bag with in the trunk of the vehicle. It is important to note that access could be gained to the trunk from within the vehicle. In addition, a digital scale was located within the backpack which had marijuana residue on the top of it. Anderson stated that he uses the scale to weigh out grams of marijuana so he doesn't get ripped off. The suspected marijuana was tested with NARK kit #8 which yielded positive presumptive results for marijuana.

Anderson was charged with violation of C.G.S. 14-215 Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended License, violation of C.G.S. 14-18(a) Failure to Display Plates, violation of C.G.S. 21a-279a(a)1 Possession of Less than 1/2oz of Marijuana, and violation of C.G.S. 21a-267(d)1 Possession of Marijuana Paraphernalia. Anderson was issued a court date of October 5, 2016 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 09/19/2016 at approximately 09:17 hours I, Officer Austin Smith was dispatched to 43 Front Street for a juvenile complaint. The caller stated that her twelve year old son was not listening to her and was refusing to go to school.

I arrived on scene at approximately 09:27 hours and located the twelve year old victim standing near the back door of the residence. It was a lightly raining and he was standing at the base of a covered staircase leading to the second floor apartment where he lived. The victim stated that he was locked out of the residence. I asked where his mother was? The victim stated that she had left in her car approximately 20-25 minutes prior to my arrival on scene.

I made contact with the victim's mother, Tamika Jackson via telephone. While speaking to Jackson on the phone she was not very cooperative and stated that she had an appointment to go to and would not be available to return home immediately. Jackson did not seem to understand that she could not simply leave her child outside and call the police to deal with him.


I explained to Jackson that she cannot lock her twelve year old son out of the house on a rainy day without adequate shelter. He had no access to a restroom and no access to food or water. The victim had no

telephone and his closest family resides in New Haven. Jackson stated that she was not concerned because he could have knocked on the neighbor's door if he needed anything.

Tamika Jackson) was arrested and charged with violating CGS 53-21 Risk of injury to a child. Jackson was processed and released on a \$10,000 non-surety bond. Jackson was scheduled to appear at GA09 Middletown on 10/03/2016.



REMARKS

On 09/21/2016 at 1350 hours, I, Officer Tyrseck was requested per Sgt. Baboolal to come into police headquarters to process the accused. Sgt. Baboolal advised me that Luz Eneida Caban was at police headquarters to sign a summons for Officer Sevigny for an assault that occurred on 09/16/2016 (case #16-22888). When Caban came into the lobby of the police department she did not have any photo identification with her. When Sgt. Baboolal attempted to identify her she became argumentative towards him. Sgt. Baboolal was attempting to identify her by other means because Caban reported that she did not have her identification on her.

While trying to explain to Caban about identifying her in the lobby of the police department while other several members of the public were present, she began to become loud and aggressive towards Sgt. Baboolal. She then began to argue with Sgt. Baboolal about her age when asked because he was trying to determine if she was a minor or not.

Sgt. Baboolal placed Caban under arrest and brought her downstairs to be placed in a holding cell to be

processed. While in the processing area, Caban used racially inflamed statements towards him. Caban advised me that DMV made a mistake on her license; her first name is Luz and her middle name is Eneida. She said DMV combined her first and last name on her identification to be seen as Luzeneida Caban. Caban also advised me that Officer Sevigny mistakenly thought her name was [redacted] (her nickname) but it is not. Caban was processed on the charge of Interfering with Police 53a-167a and Breach of Peace in the 2nd degree 53a-181. Caban was given a \$5,000.00 surety bond, a court date of 10/04/2016 at 0900 hours and placed in cell #12 due to her inability to make bond at the time of this report.
