REMARKS

On 9/10/16 at approximately 17:53 hrs, Officer Terribile and I, Officer Tiano, were dispatched to the area of Washington Street and Vine Street for a reported 2 car motor vehicle accident with unknown injuries. Dispatch stated they were receiving numerous 911 calls regarding the crash and it was being stated that

the occupants of one of the vehicles were fleeing the scene on foot.

The fleeing individuals were described as 2 black males, 1 wearing all black, who was later identified as the operator and accused, Denzel Teart and the other wearing a gray t-shirt and rolled up sweat pants, who was later identified as the accused's passenger. They were last scene running north bound on Newfield Street, away from the accident scene.

Upon our arrival at the accident scene, I saw that in the center east bound lanes of travel on Washington Street, just west of Vine Street intersection were 2 vehicles. Vehicle 1, a gray 2005 Chrysler 300c was positioned behind vehicle 2 and had sustained heavy front end damage. The front passenger compartment air bags of vehicle 2 had deployed. Vehicle 2, a gray 2008 Jeep Grand Cherokee was positioned in front of vehicle 2 and had sustained rear end damage. The operator of vehicle 2 had remained on scene with his vehicle and had stated no injuries.

The operator of vehicle 2 reported that he was traveling east bound on Washington Street approaching the intersection of Vine Street in the center lane of travel. The traffic control signal in the intersection had turned yellow and he had slowed his vehicle to a stop. While stopped, vehicle 1 had struck his vehicle from behind. He then saw both the operator and the front seat passenger exit the vehicle and flee the scene, running towards Newfield Street.

Moments later, Teart had returned to the scene of the accident. I asked Teart if he was driving, to which he stated he was operating vehicle 1. Teart stated he ran from the accident scene because did not have his license on him and ran to go get it. He was asked multiple times where he ran to and where he got his license from. Teart would only state that he went "over there" and would not provide an exact location or a reasonable explanation for fleeing.

Teart's passenger, who was located at Libery Street and Prospect Street returned to the scene. During interview of his passneger, he stated that he was a passenger in the vehicle that Teart was operating at the time of this accident. He said, after Teart struck vehicle 2 from behind, he saw Teart run from the vehicle. He said he did not know what was going on so he too decided to run until he was stopped by police.

We then located a witness to this accident, who provided a sworn written statement which they described seeing Teart's vehicle collide into vehicle 2 from behind while at the intersection of Washington Street and Vine Street. The witness described seeing Teart and his passenger flee the scene after the collision occurred.

With this witness statement and operator admissions, this provided sufficient evidence that Teart was operating the motor vehicle at the time of this collision.

Due to the facts and circumstances revealed in this investigation that were established through witness statements, operator admission and passenger statements, Teart was placed under arrested and charged with the offense of C.G.S. 14-218a* Traveling Too Fast for Conditions due to traveling at a speed which made him unable to stop his vehicle in time before colliding into the rear of vehicle 2, C.G.S. 14-224 Evading Responsibility due to fleeing an accident scene on foot without changing any motor vehicle or insurance information with the operator of vehicle 2 and C.G.S. 53a-167a Interfering with an Officer due to fleeing from an accident scene on foot giving the reason that he did not have a drivers license on him nor would he state where he ran to get his license from.

During my interaction with Teart during this investigation, he was displaying signs of being under the influence of drugs and or alcohol due to his red blood shot eyes, slurred speech, odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath and unstable balance. His conduct and evidence he was operating a motor

vehicle involved in this collision required him to be field sobriety tested. Due to Teart already being under arrest and the hazardous location this incident was in, it was not safe location to field sobriety test him at this time. There was a large amount of traffic backed up on the roadway along with debris and vehicles surrounding us. Teart would later admit to Officer Terribile that he had smoked marijuana a few hours prior to driving.

Teart agreed to conduct Standardized Field Sobriety Testing at Police headquarters. At the conclusion of testing, Teart failed all phases of testing. Teart's first breath analysis test revealed at BAC of .112 at 1923 hrs. I then administered Teart's second test which revealed a BAC of .105 at 1947 hrs. He was additionally charged with C.G.S. 14-227a Operating Under the Influence of Drugs and or Alcohol.

Teart was then booked, photographed and fingerprinted on the charges of C.G.S. 14-218a* Traveling too Fast for Conditions, C.G.S. 14-224 Evading Responsibility, C.G.S. 53-167a Interfering with Police and C.G.S. 14-227a O.U.I. (UAR #'s 8873480 and 8873479)

Teart was issued a \$10,000 surety bond and was ultimately bonded out by Watson Bailbonds. He received a court date of 9/23/16 at 0900 hrs at Middletown Superior Court G.A. 9 and was released to his Bail bondsman.



REMARKS

On 9/11/16 at approximately 1955hrs I, Officer Wasilewski, was patrolling the area of Liberty Street when I observed a white male riding a red scooter southbound on Pearl Street. The operator of the scooter, later identified as Glenn Gray, came to the intersection of Pearl Street and Liberty Street without coming to a stop at the stop sign. He then continued southbound after only slowing at the intersection.

I followed Gray on the scooter as he continued southbound. Gray turned right (westbound) from Pearl Street onto Washington Street. I activated my emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop in the

location. I asked Gray for his license but he stated he did not have it on him. He provided his name and date of birth which I ran through central dispatch. I was informed that his license was suspended. I confirmed his license was suspended on my cruiser computer. I also pulled up a picture of Gray's Department of Corrections photo to confirm his identity.

Gray was allowed to move his scooter off of the roadway and park it in a nearby parking lot for a friend to pick up. Gray was issued a misdemeanor summons (MC 380385) for violation of CGS 14-215 Operating with a Suspended License and 14-301 Stop Sign Violation. He was given a court date of 9/27/16 at 0900hrs and told he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time. He stated he understood.




Upon arrival on the scene, it was determined that she had called 911 on 9-13-16, the front desk on 9-14-16, and 911 twice on 9-15-16. She had called for Officer Tyrsek, who had dealt with her on 9-14-16. When Officer Tyrsek was not immediately available, she began calling 911. Ms. Furlong told Dispatcher that she was going to continue calling 911 until the police did their jobs and got her daughter back. On 9-15-16 she called 911 at 0844 hours and again at 0900 hours, when officers were able to be dispatched to her residence.

Ms. Furlong is angry that her daughter's father has custody of her daughter in Maine. The custody was established through GA 9 in February of 2016 by Judge. She told us multiple times that we have to go to Maine and take her daughter back to her.

There were several other issues going on and we summoned Mobile Crisis to the scene. from Mobile Crisis responded and wrote a PEC for Ms. Furlong and she was transported to Middlesex Hospital via Hunter's Ambulance. She told me that she was going to continue her 911 calls and that she is not going to go back to court for custody, as she shouldn't have to because she is a mother.



REMARKS

On 9/23/16 at approximately 2258hrs Officer St.Peter and I (Officer Wasilewski) were dispatched to an apartment building on Main Street for a report of a male and female arguing. The caller stated they were on the phone with their friend (hereby referred to Victim 1 or V1) who lived on Main Street. The caller was on the phone with V1 and overheard her arguing with V1's husband (Suspect 1 or S1). V1 hung up the phone but the caller was unable to make contact with her again. The caller then called 911 to report that she believed V1 and S1 were having a domestic argument.

Officer St.Peter and I arrived on scene and knocked on the door. S1 opened the door and allowed us inside. We then explained to S1 and V1 why were called to their apartment. Officer St.Peter spoke with V1 outside the apartment in the hallway while I spoke with S1 in the apartment.

S1 explained that he and V1 were having an argument but stated "nothing physical happened". He

suspected that V1 was cheating on him in some way and asked to look at her cell phone text messages. S1 stated V1 gave him her phone and said "go ahead and look". As he began looking through her phone she tried to grab it out of his hand to take it back. He held it away from her but she was able to take the phone back. He stated he grabbed her phone from her again but V1 began yelling and making a scene.


V1 stated she never allowed S1 to take her phone. She had the phone in her hand and was speaking to her friend but he grabbed it from her and hung up on her friend. V1's friend tried to call her back but V1 did not answer. V1's friend also tried to call S1's phone but he did not answer either. V1's friend then called the Police because she believed they were having a domestic argument. She got the phone back and called her mother to come pick her up because she did not want to stay with him. She told S1 that their relationship was over and she did not want to live with him anymore. A short time later the Police arrived.

S1 was issued a misdemeanor summons (MC 379901) for violation of CGS 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. He was given a court date of 9/26/16 at 0900hrs and told he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time. He stated he understood. S1 was also issued a Conditions of Release form with CT01, CT03, and CT05 imposed. Additionally, conditions stating "Do not use or possess a dangerous weapon" and "Do not use or possess an intoxicant or controlled substance" were also imposed.

In her statement, she stated that on 9/25/16 at approximately 11:50AM, she and her husband were sitting on their deck, which has a clear view of Bow Ln. W1 stated


that they then saw a white colored, four door SUV slowly driving west on Bow Ln., near the end of V1's driveway. W1 stated that she then was able to see the occupant of the white vehicle, which was V1's ex-wife. 

While at S1 residence, she was taken into custody for violation of C.G.S. 53a-223-Violation of a Protective Order. She was placed in the rear seat of my cruiser for transport. S1 was booked and processed under UAR 8873533. She was issued a court date of 9/26/16 at 0900 hours at GA 9, Middletown. S1 was later released on a Promise To Appear. There is no further information. REMARKS

On 9/20/16, at approximately 15:41 hours, I, Officer Foss-Rugan responded to the area of # 15 Rapallo Avenue to conduct a wellbeing check. It was reported that there was a white and blue camper parked on the side of the road occupied by a white male. The reporting party said that the white male was nodding of and appeared to be overdosing on narcotics.

Upon my arrival, I located the camper which was a 1997 Ford Superduty bearing VT registration GTW331. I made contact with the complainant. 
When Wilder tried to walk away from me, I grabbed a hold of his right arm. At that point, Wilder became combative and uncooperative so officers had to assist him to the ground where he was placed in handcuffs. During a search of his person, Officer Delima located a small Altoid tin in his front pocket which contained prescription pills. The pills inside the Altoid tin consisted of six Gabapentin 300 mg and one Oxycodone 10 mg.

I asked Wilder why he was giving me such a hard time and he continued with his verbal escapade of yelling and swearing at me. Wilder told other officers on scene that he and his sister had driven to Middletown from Vermont as he was working at a fair in Connecticut this weekend making fried dough. Wilder said that his sister drove the camper to Rapallo Avenue. Wilder did not provide us with a name for his sister or phone number and the complainant said that they were outside the entire time and never saw anyone with Wilder in the camper. Wilder continued by saying his sister was on Main Street in Middletown selling fried dough out of a food trailer. We checked the area, and there were no food trailers on Main Street. Wilder later told Middletown Fire staff that he drove the camper to Rapallo Avenue.

Middletown Police dispatch ran Wilder's name for warrants/hits and it was revealed that he had a valid operator's license out of Vermont. Dispatch advised that DMV records showed that Wilder was supposed to only operate a motor vehicle with a ignition interlock device due to being previously arrested multiple times for driving under the influence. Officers checked the camper and there was no ignition interlock device installed.

I issued Wilder a Misdemeanor Summons MC 380436 charging him with the following: Interfering with a police officer 53a-167a and 21a-257- Prescription not in original container with a court date of 9/27/16 at 09:00 hours at Middlesex Superior Court.







A check with dispatch revealed that the accused had two failure to appear warrants for his arrest in addition to the hardcopy.

Per the warrant, Delacruz was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-60 Assault 2nd, violation of C.G.S. 53a-62 Threatening 2nd, violation of C.G.S. 53a-64bb Strangulation 2nd, and violation of C.G.S. 53-21 Risk of Injury to a Minor. Per the warrant, Delacruz was held on a \$25,000 cash bond and will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on September 26, 2016 at 0900 hours.


The warrant was cancelled from the system.
