REMARKS

On 9/6/2016, at approximately 1215 hours, I was received a call from the Asset Protection Detective from Stop and Shop at 416 East Main Street. I had investigated a complaint of shoplifting that occurred on 9/5/2016 and identified a suspect. The Asset Protection Detective told me that suspect was in the store. The Asset Protection Detective contacted me and told me that the suspect had a shopping cart full of Monster Energy Drinks. She said he paid for one case, but left without paying for the others. The Asset Protection Detective said she was following him out into the parking lot.

Upon my arrival I found I [redacted] in front of the store with a male and Kaylyn Klaneski. The Asset Protection Detective was recovering (2) 4 packs (\$8.99 each + 20 cent bottle deposit) and (3) 12 packs (\$18.99 each + 50 cent bottle deposit) of Monster energy drinks from the trunk of [redacted] car. the Asset Protection Detective told me that the suspect had fled the scene towards East Main Street on foot. I had additional units check the area for the suspect with negative results.

The Asset Protection Detective told me that at approximately 1213 hours the suspect and Klaneski entered the store and went to the soft drink aisle. The suspect proceeded to place the Monster energy drinks in his cart. She said she watched the

REMARKS

Domestic Violence-Assault in the Third Degree 09/06/2016 @1814 hours.

On 09/06/2016 at approximately 1814 hours, Officer M. DelMauro and I, Officer DiMassa were dispatched to an address in Middletown to investigate a domestic dispute complaint. It was reported by the caller who will be referred to as V1 (Victim 1) throughout this report, that his mother who will be referred to S1 (Suspect 1) throughout this report, was intoxicated and she punched him in the face. He later provided me with a statement explaining this incident. I then observed a red mark and a small scratch the right side of his face, in the area of his temple. The red mark was approximately one in wide and stretched from his temple to the bottom of his right eye.

After speaking with V1, I went into the residence to speak with S1. S1 appeared heavily intoxicated as she


was slurring her speech. Her eyes were water and glassy and she had an overwhelmingly strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. I asked her what happened tonight, and she was very short with me, stating nothing. She then denied that she struck V1 in any way. S1 would then demand things from me again, like getting her phone and going to turn on her dryer.

S1 was then placed into custody for violation of C.G.S 53a-61-Assault in the Third Degree and 53a-182-Disorderly Conduct. She was placed in the rear seat of my cruiser for transport. While at headquarters S1 was booked and processed under UAR 8873463. S1 was issued a court date of 9/7/16 at 0900 hours, at GA 9, Middletown. S1 was held on a \$10,000 Surety bond.

As I was processing S1, she stated that she and V1 got into an argument because of her drinking. She stated that V1 was very upset with her because she had not left for Rushford yet as they both planned. She stated that when she came home from her friends house, V1 was home and became upset with her because she came home intoxicated.

There is no further information. This case is closed by arrest.

REMARKS

On 09/06/2016, at approximately 10:46 hours, while conducting patrol checks on Wesleyan University property this investigator received a call from Wesleyan University Public Safety reporting that there was a suspicious person sitting 151 on the front porch steps of the (International House) which is a student dormitory located at 151 Church Street Middletown, CT 06457.

The suspicious person matched the descriptors of an unidentified suspect that was involved in a series of burglaries that occurred on Wesleyan University campus on the previous night of 09/05/16.

This investigator responded to the area of 151 Church Street and did not observed anyone sitting on the front steps of that property. I then proceeded to travel northbound on High Street and just prior to the intersection of Wyllis Avenue I observed a tall, thin, black male carrying a backpack that matched the descriptors of the suspect previously sitting on the front steps of the International House on Church Street walking northbound on the sidewalk.

The male suspect did not appeared to be a Wesleyan University student, so this investigator proceeded to make field contact with the suspect.

The suspect later identified as Jeffrey Granfield (AGE 46) initially declined at first to provide his name and then proceeded to stand on the roadway of High Street instead of the sidewalk. Granfield appeared to be nervous and kept looking around his surroundings. I initially suspected that he was going to attempt to run away from me so I requested another officer to respond to my location to assist me.

Members of the Narcotics unit arrived on scene to assist. I then advised Granfield that I was going to pat down his outer clothing for weapons for his own safety as well as our safety. Granfield was verbally defensive during the entire field encounter and did not want to provide any information on what he was doing in the vicinity of Wesleyan University campus.

I first checked his backpack and found the backpack to only contain a cigarette lighter and a small hand held flashlight. I then asked him why he was walking around with an empty backpack and Granfield declined to give any explanation. Upon checking his left front sweat pant pocket this investigator felt a bulge and I immediately asked him what was inside his pocket. Granfield then said out loud "It's a cocaine pipe!"

Granfield was subsequently transported to police headquarters without incident. At headquarters Granfield was advised of his Miranda rights and processed on 1 count of being in violation of C.G.S. SEC 21a-267(a) possession of drug paraphernalia.


During the booking process Granfield told this investigator that prior to being stopped by police his intentions were to walk to the north-end of the city from South Main Street and randomly find anyone that was willing to share their crack/cocaine with him. I asked Granfield if he had anything to do with the burglaries that occurred on 09/05/16 and he denied any involvement.

Granfield is currently on probation and has an extensive history of criminal arrest and is a convicted felon.

At the request of Wesleyan University Public Safety, Granfield was advised that he is not to return to any of the Wesleyan University property.

The arrestee Mr. Jeffrey Granfield (AGE 46) was unable to post bail and was held overnight in lieu of \$ 500.00 surety-bond. Court-set for Wednesday 09/7/2016 at 09:00 hours. At GA-09, located on 1 Court Street Middletown, CT 06457.

REMARKS

On August 29, 2016 around 0219 hours I (Ofc. 
Upon approach I made contact with the operator John Prestage who was positively identified upon presentation of a valid CT operators license. Immediately upon making contact with Prestage I could smell the heavy distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the passenger compartment of the vehicle and Prestage informed me that he drank too much, was drunk and shouldn't be driving. I observed that Prestage's eyes were bloodshot and glassy and that his speech was slurred. Sergeant Smith and Officer Arroyo arrived on scene as backup officers and to assist.

Prestage failed all on scene field sobriety tests, was placed under arrest and transported to MPD HQ where he consented to a breath test. Prestage was tested utilizing the Drager 9150 alcotest machine and found to have a B.A.C. of .1669 at 0300 hours and .1644 at 0323 hours.

Prestage was issued CT misdemeanor summons # MC330354 for violations of CGS 14-227 Operating under the influence of alcohol and or drugs and 14-96a(a) Failure to have devices illuminated at night. Prestage was assigned a \$500.00 non surety bond and a court appearance date of 9/8/16 @ GA#9. Prestage's operators license was seized for a 24 hour hold pursuant to state law. Prestage was provided a copy of his test results, then released and picked up at the department by his father. Case closed, nothing further.
