## REMARKS

On September 07, 2016, at approximately 1932 hours, I Officer Bloom was dispatched to an undisclosed location in Middletown, CT for a reported domestic.

Victim #1 said she got into a verbal domestic with Walter Tixi-Vasquez (25). She said Tixi-Vasquez approached her vehicle and punched her side mirror, punched the window and kicked her vehicle. Victim #1 said Tixi-Vasquez broke the passenger side mirror as a result of his punch. I observed the glass hanging from the side mirror housing (estimated value to replace \$25), what appeared to be the side of a hand on the front passenger side window and a shoe scuff on the passenger side front door. Victim #1 was threatened and afraid Tixi- Vasquez would harm her or their child as a result of his behavior.



## REMARKS

On 8/31/2016 Detectives from the Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit prepared to execute a signed narcotics search and seizure warrant on Robert Scott and 258 Saybrook Road apartment 8 Middletown, Connecticut. The tenant of 258 Saybrook Road is Robert Scott.

At approximately 1115 hours we proceeded to 258 Saybrook Road apartment 8. We loudly announced our presence and intent to search a signed search and seizure warrant and made entry through the open apartment door. Scott was found in the living room and detained without incident.

Scott was searched and found to be in possession of \$291 in US currency in his right shorts pocket. An additional \$20 of marked narcotics unit funds used to purchase crack cocaine from Scott was also found in his pocket.

Once the residence was secured Detectives began a thorough search of the apartment. The following items were found:

In the living room:

1. Black track phone found on the couch
2. 2 clear plastic sandwich baggies commonly used to package illicit drugs found on the couch
3. Lg black touchscreen cellular phone found on the couch
4. Glass pipe smoking pipe used to some crack cocaine found on the couch
5. Broken cellular phone found on the couch
6. Metal marijuana grinder with marijuana residue inside found on the couch
7. Liberty Bank card found on the couch
8. Pieces of clear plastic baggies commonly used to package cocaine found under the couch
9. Pieces of clear plastic baggies commonly used to package cocaine found under the table
10. Suspected partially burnt marijuana cigarette found in bag hanging in closet
11. Numerous partially burnt marijuana cigarettes found in the ashtray
12. Black smart phone found on the loveseat
13. White Samsung phone found on the loveseat
14. Broken iPhone found on the loveseat

In the kitchen:

1. Clear plastic sandwich baggies with corners torn off commonly used to package illicit drugs found on the counter
2. Razor which are commonly used to cut large amounts of drugs into smaller amounts found on the counter
3. Box of plastic baggies found in a drawer

A digital scale with suspected cocaine residue was found in a jacket pocket hanging on Scott's door.


When asked if there was any crack cocaine in the residence Scott said, "If there is any it is in my coat pocket or in the car". When none was located he said "I must be out".

The suspected cocaine residue tested positive for the presumptive presence of crack cocaine with NIK wipe. The suspected marijuana tested positive for the presumptive presence of marijuana with NARK 8.

Scott was issued MSC229374 and issued a PTA for violation of CGS 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and 21a-279a(a)(1). He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 9/23/2016 at 0900 hours.
