ITEM #1 REVISED BID PROPOSAL PAGES

ITEM #2

Technical Specification Page 700-8. Item II-11, 3” Concrete Mud Mat, has been revised. Payment for 3” Concrete Mud Mat, if necessary, will be paid for at the contract unit price for Item 65, Class A Concrete.

DELETE Page 700-8 of the technical Specifications; and

INSERT the revised Page 700-8 attached.

ITEM II-11 3" CLASS A CONCRETE MUD MAT

- (a) This Item will be measured for payment based upon the actual cubic yardage of 3" thickness Class A concrete "mud mat" placed on undisturbed subgrade below pipes and/or structures, as necessary due to soil conditions, as determined by the Engineer, within the limits for trench excavation and/or structure excavation stated in Section 102 of the technical specifications, unless otherwise approved by the Engineer.
- (b) This work shall be paid for at the Contract unit price per cubic yard for Item 65 "Class A Concrete", complete in place to the maximum trench/excavation limits allowed by the specifications/details, which price shall include furnishing and placing the concrete, and all other materials, tools, equipment and labor incidental thereto.

ITEM II-12 ROADWAY SUBBASE

- (a) Roadway Subbase for providing a stable subbase between the processed aggregate base and the subgrade material shall be measured for payment based upon the actual number of cubic yards furnished, placed and compacted within the limits defined by the details or as determined by the Engineer. Roadway Subbase shall conform to Section 107 of these Specifications.
- (b) This work will be paid for at the Contract unit price per cubic yard for "Roadway Subbase"; complete in place, which price shall include all materials, tools, equipment and labor incidental thereto.

ITEM II-13 RIPRAP

- (a) This work will be measured for payment by the actual number of square yards of modified riprap placed on a prepared base to the thickness detailed and accepted.
- (b) The unit price for this Item shall be full compensation for clearing and grubbing, earth excavation, furnishing and installing the granular base material and modified riprap to the thicknesses detailed and to the limits shown on the drawings, or as directed by the Engineer, grading and compaction, disposal of surplus material, and all labor, materials, tools and equipment necessary to complete the Item to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

III INCIDENTAL WORK

ITEM III-1 6" UNDERDRAIN

- (a) This work will be measured for payment by the actual number of linear feet of underdrains, foundation underdrains, slope underdrains, structural underdrains and outlets for underdrains, completed, accepted and measured in place. Trench excavation will not be measured for payment. Rock-in-trench will be measured for payment in accordance with Item I-1.
- (b) This work will be paid for at the Contract unit price per linear foot for "6" Underdrain", complete in place, which price shall include pipe of the size specified, elbows, tees, wyes, couplings, fitting, trench excavation and support, geotextile, furnishing and placing No. 8 crushed stone, aggregate, sand, backfill and compaction, and equipment, tools, material and labor incidental thereto.
