Dear Sunny Time Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to a fun and safe summer at Middletown Recreation Division. Our staff is looking forward to meeting your child and making your child's experience a memorable one, filled with good times and great friendships both old and new. We will be located at Bielefield School ~ please enter the building through the front door if you are dropping off your children. We offer seven weeks of summer camp starting June 20th until August 5th. There is no camp on Monday July 4, 2016.

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself. My name is Reilly Tabor and I will be the director of Sunny Time this summer. I have worked for the Middletown Recreation and Community Center as a paraprofessional for the past 3 years and this is my second year as a camp director and I am super excited! During the school year, I am a special education teacher for an Integrated Preschool program in Wallingford. Before that I was a special education teacher right here in Middletown. I graduated from the University of Delaware in 2009 with my bachelor's degree in Early Childhood and Special Education. Over the summers, I have always found myself working at a summer camp, starting way back when I was just 14. I have worked at Holiday Hill Day Camp as well as the Cheshire YMCA's Camp Quinnipiac.

Lunches and Snacks:

Bielefield School is a qualifying site for CRT lunches. We will receive free snacks and lunches with a drink daily. A menu will be made available, however, it will not always be exact; please understand that the menu may fluctuate. We encourage campers to bring their own water bottles to keep hydrated throughout the day.

Field Trips and Swimming:

Your child will be provided with a Recreation field trip T-shirt. T-Shirts must be worn on field trips so that our campers are easily identifiable in crowded off-site areas. Campers will take home their shirt following their first field trip.

We travel off site twice a week, once for a field trip and once for swimming at Veteran's Memorial Pool. The children do not need to wear their field trip shirts for swim day. Every Thursday we will spend the afternoon at Vet's Pool. Children can wear their swimsuits to camp under their clothes, but we do suggest a change of clothes. Please be sure to pack a labeled towel and sunscreen. Vet's Pool does not allow any goggles and requires that all floatation devices are Coast Guard approved. All campers are swim tested and each group is monitored by lifeguards and camp staff at all times. Campers that do not meet basic height requirements will swim in the toddler pool. **PLEASE, if you have questions or concerns about swimming for the first time, contact me! Please bring a labeled bottle of sunscreen!**

Personal Items:

Please provide a labeled book bag for your child to bring to camp every day. No electronics, games, cards or money should be brought to camp. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items. We have a lost and found area at camp.

Camp Sunny Time typically has a 'rest' time when we are at Bielefield for the entire day. During rest time campers can choose to read or simply rest their bodies to recharge after a long morning of activities. If you would like, you can send in a labeled towel for your child to use during rest.

Parent transportation

Camp **BEGINS** at 9:00 A.M. Please do not drop off participants at camp before 8:55 A.M., as the counselors are not on duty until that time. Camp **ENDS** at 3:00 P.M. Students **MUST** be picked up by 3:00 P.M. sharp. If anyone else is picking up your child that is not on the registration form, we must have a note indicating who is picking up your child and the person must provide a photo ID upon arrival. There is a sign-in/sign-out sheet for all parent pickups and drop-offs that must be signed when arriving at camp and leaving camp.

Clothing:

During the day, your child will be participating in many fun group activities both inside and outside. Comfortable, play clothes are recommended. As a safety precaution sneakers are required at camp. No sandals or flip-flops will be permitted. Sandals may be BROUGHT on swim day or water day, but they cannot be worn to camp.

Rules (for campers):

- Inappropriate behavior cannot be tolerated.
- Respect yourself, other campers and all staff!
- Keep your hands, feet, objects and belongings to yourselves.
- Treat others as you want to be treated.
- No swearing, put-downs or bullying.

Consequences:

- Verbal warning and/or a phone call home
- If a child misbehaves or endangers her/himself or others he will receive a disciplinary action form that will be sent home for a parent's signature. A signed copy must be returned to camp in order for your child to attend camp. If a child receives three write-ups they will be suspended from camp for the duration of the summer. If any participant displays unsafe behavior at camp, they may be suspended from off-site activities. A child may be suspended immediately for a serious behavior incident without a refund.

Please know that we want every child to have a fun and successful summer. Please support us, as we support the efforts of you and other adults in their lives to model good citizenship and to set reasonable expectations for our campers. Remember, we are all on the same "team."

Health:

- A child that has a fever or vomiting cannot return to camp until 24 hours after symptoms end.
- You may be asked for a doctor's note from the camp director or camp nurse as needed.
- Please make any allergies known to staff.

Miscellaneous:

- Please check the Sign-In table for take home announcements. Parents of bus riders, check their book bag for notices.
- If your child rides the bus, please note: someone **MUST** be present to pick up your child upon the bus arrival at drop off time.

I will have my phone turned on between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If at any time you cannot reach me, please leave a message, I will return your call in a timely manner. Thank you for sending your child to Middletown Recreation camp. We are all committed to providing your child with a fun camp experience this summer! Please remember all policies and regulations are put into place to ensure the safety of your child. Our experienced staff works hard to provide your children with an unforgettable summer.

Participant Behavior Rules

Please review the "Participant's Behavior Rules" with your child so they are familiar with the program's expectations prior to arrival. Please be advised that if your child does not comply with these rules, he/she may be asked to leave and no refunds will be provided.

In order to ensure the safety of our participants and to provide the most rewarding and enjoyable recreation experience we can, we must insist on a standard of behavior that includes the following:

- ⇒ Children must respect staff, other participants and equipment, at all times.
- ⇒ Children must practice fair play, honesty, and good sportsmanship.
- ⇒ Children must be able to cooperate in a large group setting.
- ⇒ Children must follow instructions and rules.
- ⇒ Children must be aware of obvious dangers (roads, water, etc.).
- ⇒ Children must be able to interact positively with fellow participants and staff.
- ⇒ Children must be able to use the bathroom independently.
- ⇒ Children must stay with their group and listen to the staff members.

The following will not be allowed and will be grounds for dismissal:

- Inappropriate, disrespectful, uncooperative or disruptive behavior
- Abusive language and inappropriate gestures
- Injuring another participant, staff or person through an inappropriate action
- Fighting or putting your hands on any other person in a harmful or inappropriate way
- Throwing things in anger
- Biting, spitting on others, equipment or property
- Stealing or misuse of property
- Bringing cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, firearms, knives or weapons of any sort on the bus or to camp
- Any other behavior that the City of Middletown deems disruptive to its programs or compromises the safety of others

We understand that Parents/Guardians and participant (s) will be held responsible for participant (s) actions at rec programs. We understand that part of the recreation experience involves activities and interactions that may be new to my child, and that they come with certain risks. I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by the rules. My child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in immediate dismissal from a recreation program with no refund. 
